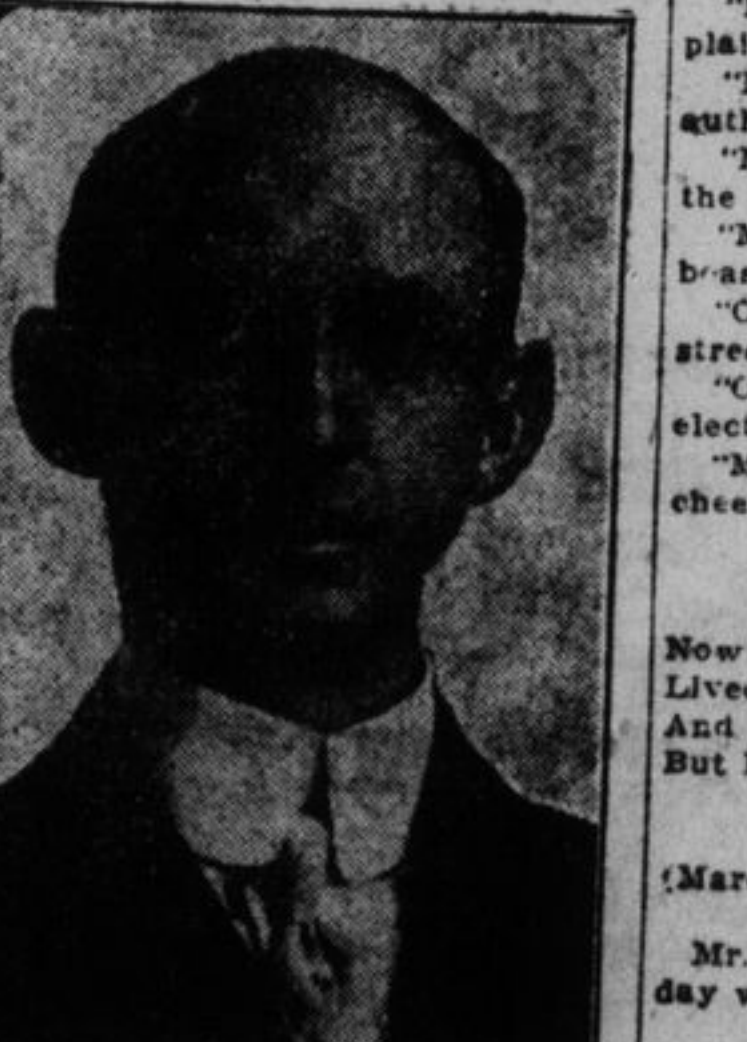

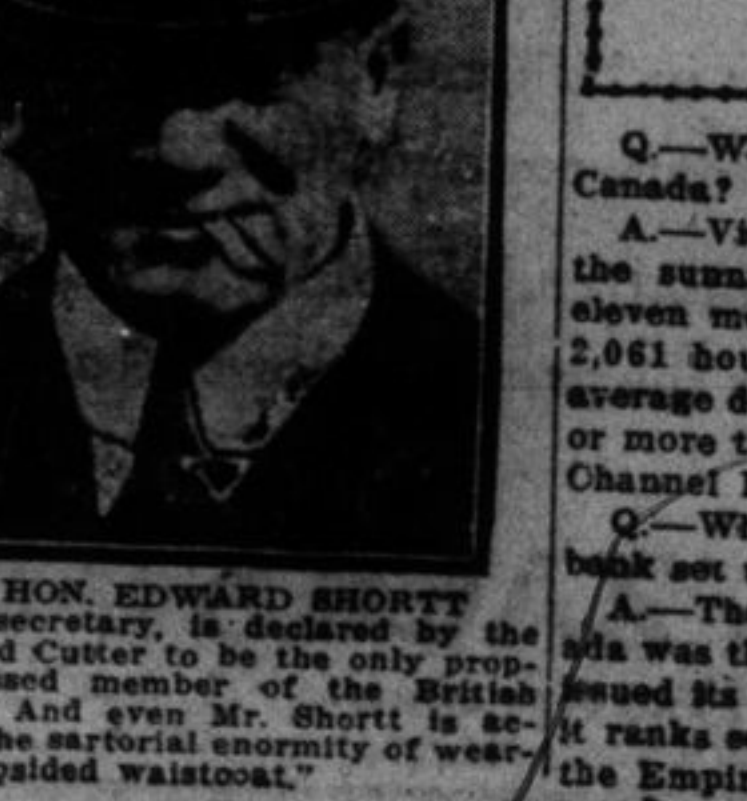


JOHN C. ELLIOTT. Former M.P.P. for West Middlesex, who is slated for the position of Crown Attorney for the County of Middlesex.
