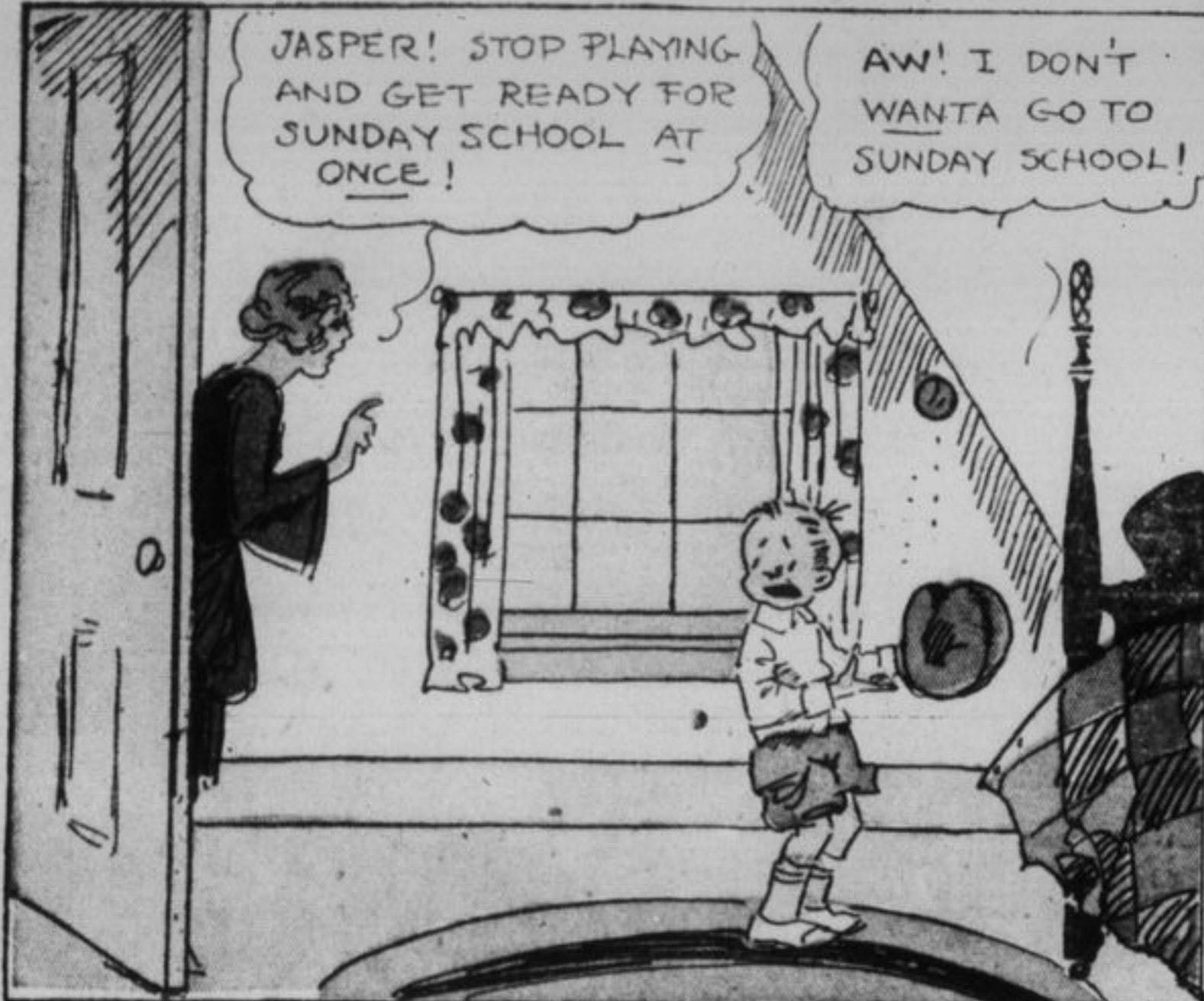

WHY, JASPER! I AM ASHAMED OF YOU! DO YOU WANT TO BE A HEATHEN?

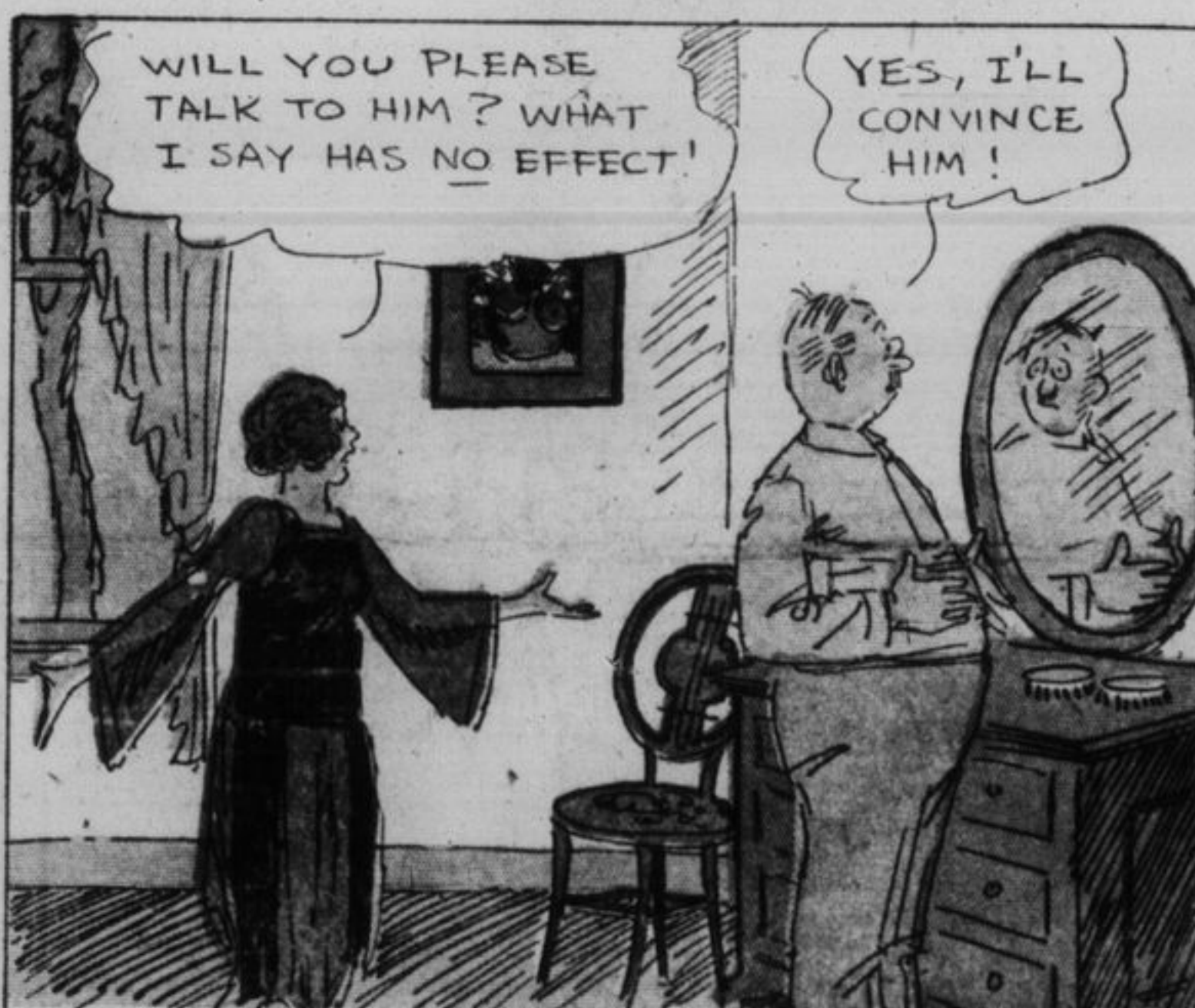


WELL IT'S PRETTY SOFT FOR HEATHENS! THEY NEVER EVEN HEARD O' CHURCH!

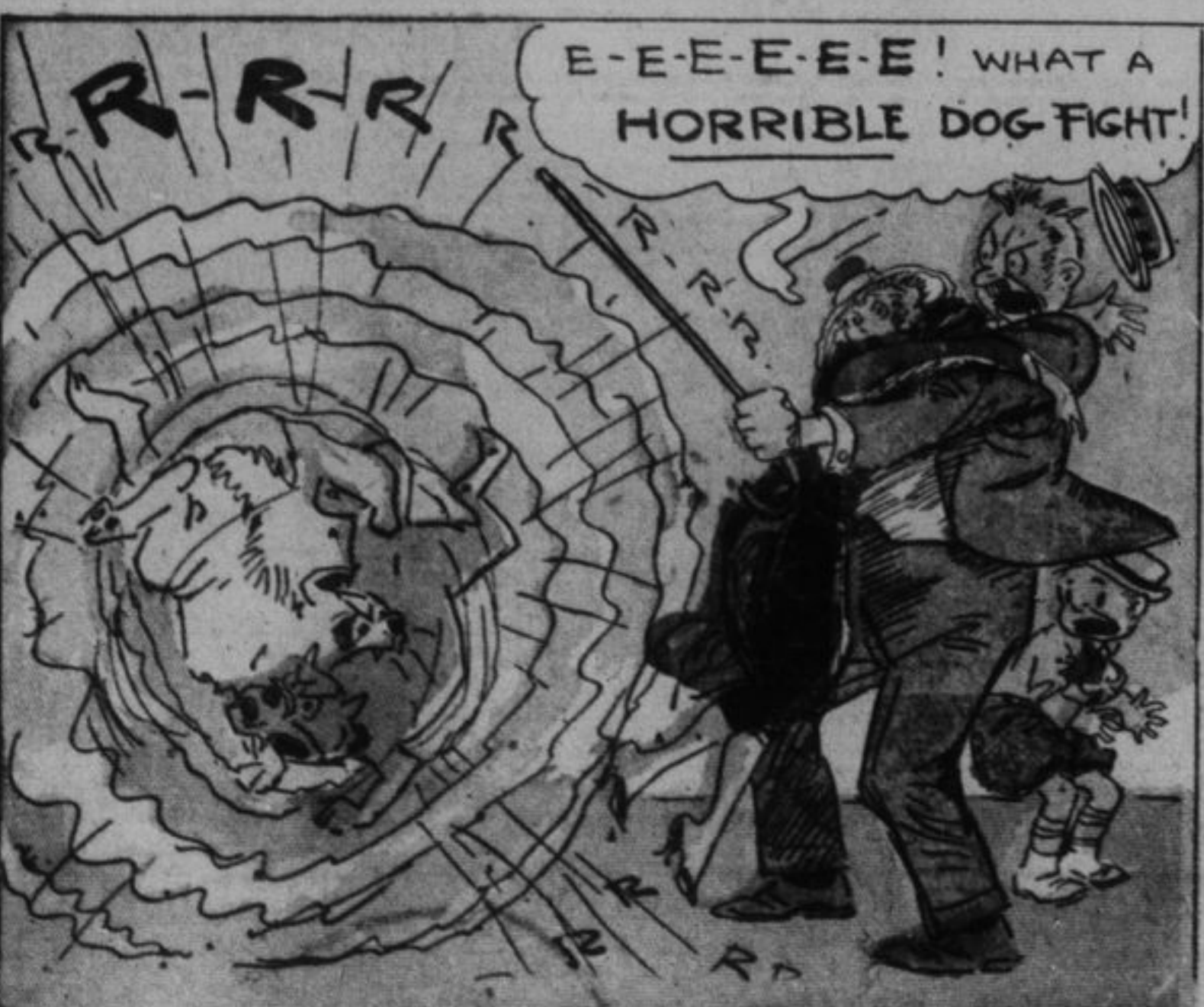


LISTEN! WHEN YOU DO ANYTHING GOOD, LIKE GOING TO CHURCH, YOU ARE REWARDED, SEE!
