BRITISH Columbia offers the best still remaining, easily accessible big game hunting territory on the continent, it is not necessary to go far afield from the railway and some of the best hunting grounds are as follows: Beginning at the east, there is the East Kootenay district, reached from Invermere. Two

ing ducks, geese, pinnated and ruffled grouse, with some snipe and plover at
