Much More Work. Judge Lavelle says his work in the division courts has been greatly in-

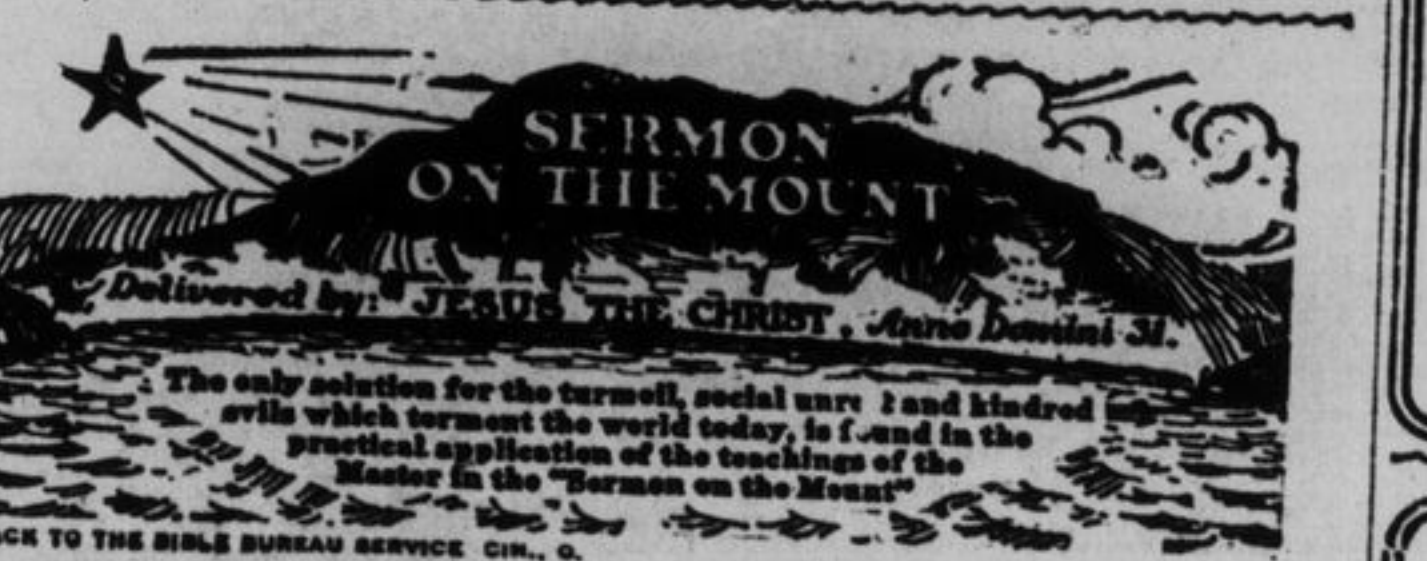
