PEOPLE VOTE IN FAVOR OF DAYLIGHT SAVING

Carry Referendum by Majority of 571—Land Purchase By-law Also Passed.

Both the referendum on daylight saving and the by-law to purchase the Murook farm land for industrial purposes for \$9,000 were carried by the ratifiers. Daylight saving met with the approval of the people by a vote of 2,019 to 1,448, a majority of 571. This was an unlooked for result in most quarters. The land by-law got through by 1,041 to 1,006, a close shave, but enough to make the purchase, which is in the interests of the city. The votes on these two measures were as follows:

ALMA MATER ELECTIONS

W. Powell, B.A., Medical-Science Candidate, Was Elected as President.

The Queen's Alma Mater Society elections held Monday afternoon resulted in a victory for the Medicine-Science party. Besides electing their candidate for the presidency, W. A. Powell, B.A., the successful party captured seven of the nine positions which they contested. Arts-Levans-Theology won but two offices besides the two granted to Levana. It was a great victory for the medicals and the engineers, after being in the background for several years, and at the meeting in the evening the successful students made the most of the occasion.

The officers were elected as follows: Hon. Pres. Principal R. Bruce Taylor; president, W. A. Powell, Medicine; 1st vice-president, V. A. Minnes, Science; 2nd vice-president, R. G. Davidson, medicine; secretary, D. B. Taylor, arts; assistant secretary, Miss K. Lockhart; treasurer, A. R. Stevenson, medicine; critic, G. E. Flanagan, medicine; athletic stick, O. A. Carson, science, (accl.); committee, Miss F. Kelly; "Bud" Thomas, arts; D. W. Boucher, medicine; H. Haslam, science.

The elections aroused great faculty spirit with the result that an exceptionally large proportion of the vote was polled. The parties as such were very evenly divided numerically and the result of the vote, which was a landslide in one direction, showed that the students broke away from party lines. All afternoon the election committees by incessant work brought to a conclusion the hard campaign.

The election results were announced in Grant Hall in the evening to a crowd that filled the hall. The officers were carried to the platform and in neat addresses, punctuated by faculty yells, thanked their supporters and pledged themselves to work for their alma mater. The "also-rans" were called on to speak.

One of the features of the election was the large vote polled for "Bud" Thomas, who headed the committee-men. His popularity at the college is unchallenged. Among the other rugbyists on the executive Oran Carson and Pres. McLeod, both elected by acclamation. W. Powell, the president-elect, had a majority of about eighty. He is a graduate in arts and is in fourth year medicine.

Some of the candidates ran very closely. This was particularly true in the assistant secretaryship where Miss Lockhart had a majority of four in the nine hundred votes polled.

In the first of the interfaculty rugby games, science defeated arts by a score of 13-4 on Monday afternoon. Science now meets medicine, the present holders of the championship in the final game.
