Mr. Cunningham's Address. Mr. Cunningham followed Mr. Nottle, and declared that the real issue in the case was as to whether Rev. Dr. Lawson had proved that Dr. Geddes had treated his wife as badly as had been alleged—that his conduct had been of such a character as to warrant the taking away of his diploma; that Dr. Geddes was responsible for her state of health, and that generally, he had acted in an unprofessional manner.

Two Gentlemen at Odds. "These two gentlemen are at odds," remarked his lordship, in opening his address to the jury, after which he instructed the jury on the meaning of libel and slander.

Had Great Powers. Continuing, his lordship stated that that the position of a Methodist minister could not be ignored. The ministry was composed of men who had done a lot of hard work.
