Hemp Crop in Philippines. Abaca (Manila hemp.) though superseded by sugar in the list of Philippine exports in the irse Philippine exports since 1920, stil holds the premier place among native industries, giving employment to many millions of people and affecting the purchasing power of the country more largely than any other raw material. The increase in abaca production during the year was phenomenal. Shipments were large, materially reducing the stocks held in the islands and eliminating all old fibre so that only good merchantable stocks remain.

North Russia Exporting Meat. A newspaper despatch from Get your straw hat attended to Vardo, in North Norway, forwarded by Consul Ifft, indicates that the food shortage in Northern Russia is no longer serious. The Soviet cutter Komiteron arrived at Vardo recently with 5,000 kilograms of frozen remdeer meat, 17,000 partridges and 2,000 ptarmigans, which were offered for sale. Several Norwegian cutters loaded with fish and other foodstuffs, which recently went to Murmansk, have returned to Vardo with their cargoes unsold.

> Important Consolidations Ahead Arrangements are now under consideration in the Netherlands providing for the absorption of the Holland South African Lines by the United Netherlands Company. The completion of this deal depends upon the approval of the Govern nent, which has heretofore granted ubsidies to the latter company. The Amsterdam Rubber Company and the Netherlands Rubber Company are considering an amalgamation which would form the largest rubber company in the country.
