CALLED SPIRITUALISM A MASTER DELUSION

Address by Evangelist Lindsay at the Gospel Tent, Barrie Street.

"Spiritualism is the work of demons. It is the master delusion of the world. It originated with the lie that Satan told Eve when he declared she would not die for eating the forbidden fruit, and it will go down with all liars in the lake of fire when the devil and his followers are destroyed."

Evangelist Wesley Lindsay in emphasizing the "False Claims of Spiritualism," in his lecture at the gospel tent on Barrie street, near York, last night, declared that "When spiritualism is tested by the divine criterion, its revelations and pretensions vanish into the air. Its communications are no more like the messages of the prophets and apostles than a counterfeit note is like a genuine one; and a careful consideration of the two settles at once the question of their rival claims."

"Spiritualism denies the inspiration and authority of the Bible and the necessity for the atonement; it proclaims the divinity of man while denying the divinity of Christ. It exalts bitter opponents of Christianity to positions of honor in the spirit realm. But the very essence of its teaching consists of a certain spiritualization — and by that the dissipation of those conceptions of truth and duty which an individual derives from reason and revelation, and upon which rest the stability of the home and of the state. Thus it leads the mind into mental and moral confusion and brings about a general weakening of the bonds of moral obligation, with a resulting antagonism to law both human and divine."
