SAVED FROM JAIL SOJOURN

The Home Bank Directors Put Up Heavy Bail.

COATSWORTH WILL DECIDE

Toronto, Nov. 10.—With their re-appearance in court next Friday guaranteed by bail bonds totalling about one million dollars, ten directors and officials of the Home Bank are again at liberty. They had a narrow escape yesterday from spending the week-end and Thanksgiving day in jail. As it was, they were in custody of the sheriff's office for about seven hours, during which time their lawyers and crown counsel McCarthy, K.C., wrangled over legal points and court procedure.
