YOUR HEALTH.

By Raymond S. Copeland. M.D., Comissioner of Health New York City.)

There is a popular idea that outof-doors is the one thing necessary to give you good health.

Of course this is not the fact. Fresh air and out-of-door life are essential to health, but in and of themselves they are not sufficient to keep you well.

The other day I spoke to an audience of ten or fifteen hundred persons, almost all of them mountaineers who spend most of their time in the open. I think I never spoke to a group, even in the slums of a great city, where there were so many showing evidence of under-nourishment and ill-health.

There are many factors contributing to poor health, but one of the chief of them is found in bad teeth, In the rich cities where public health education has become almost an obsession—a good one—there is so much emphasis placed on the importance of good teeth and dental care that the young folks, certainly, and most of the older ones have well-cared-for-teeth.
