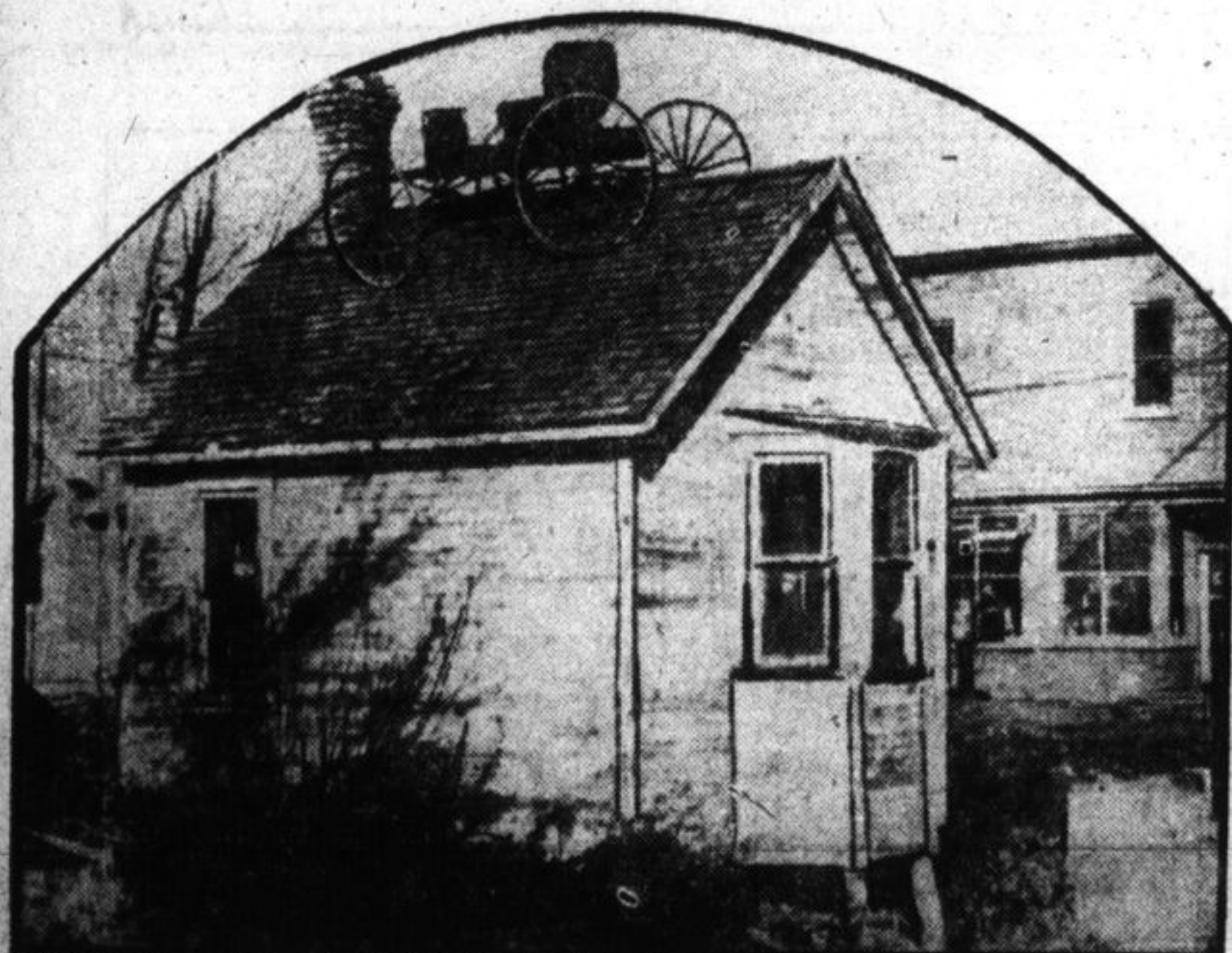

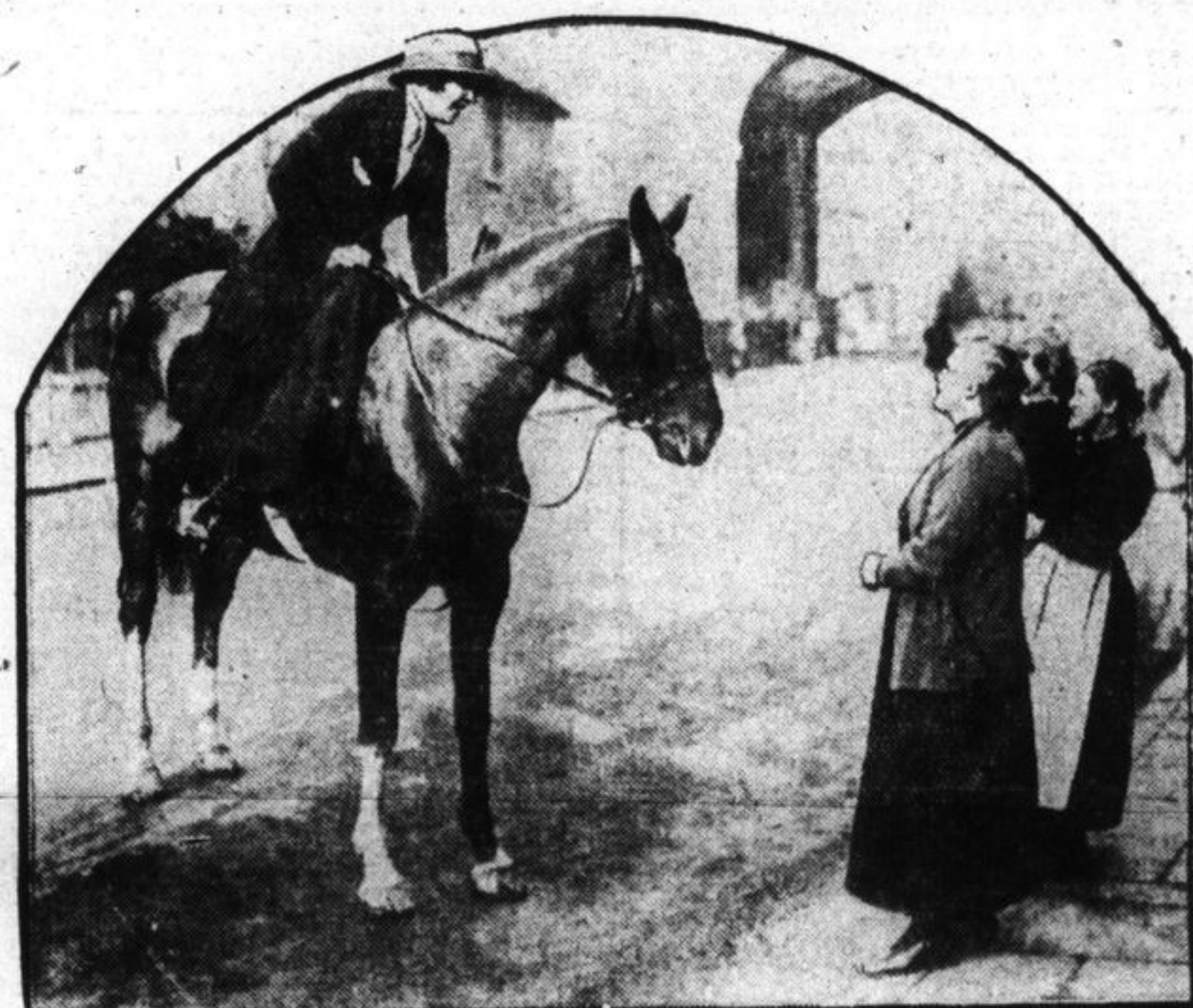

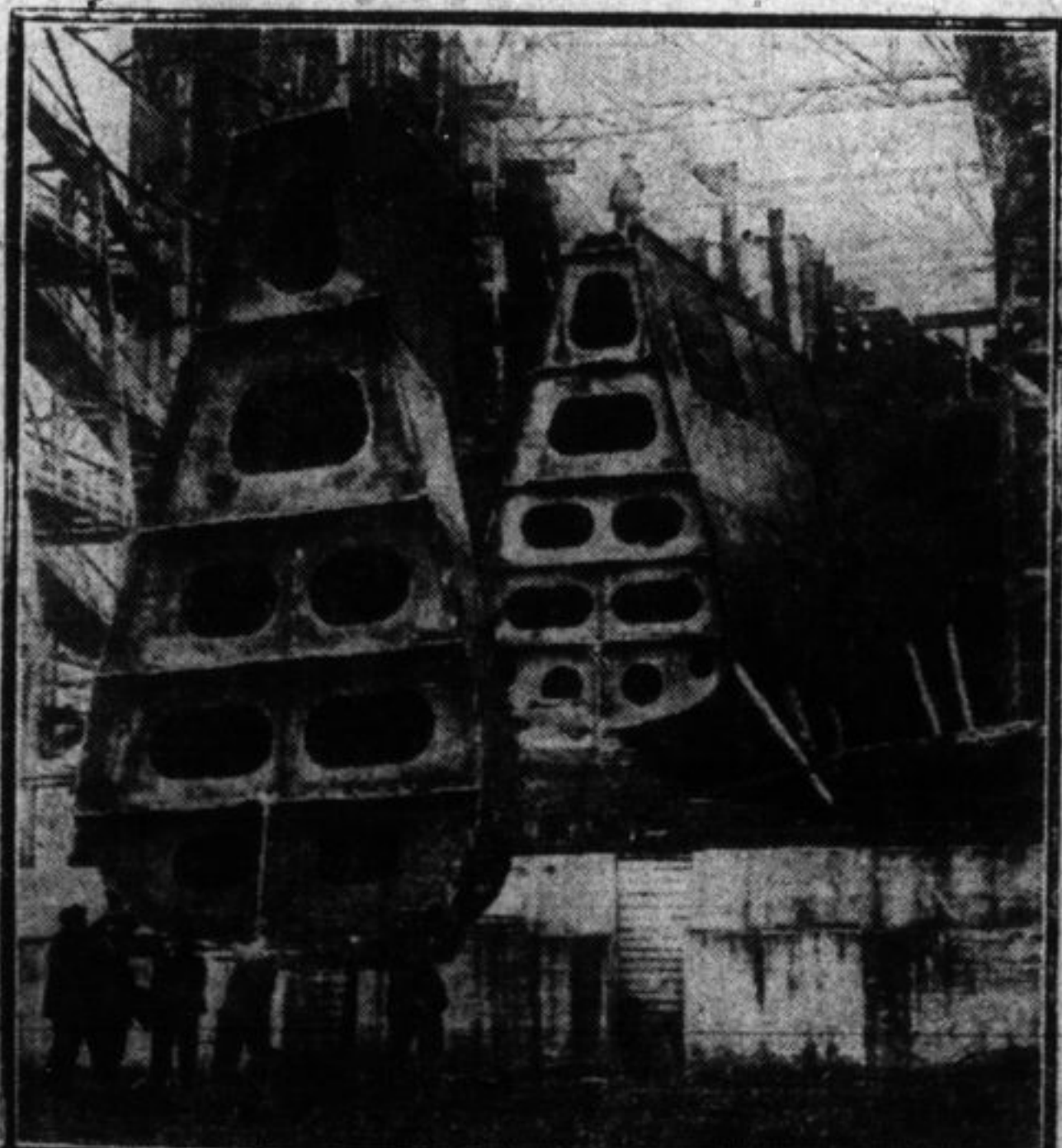

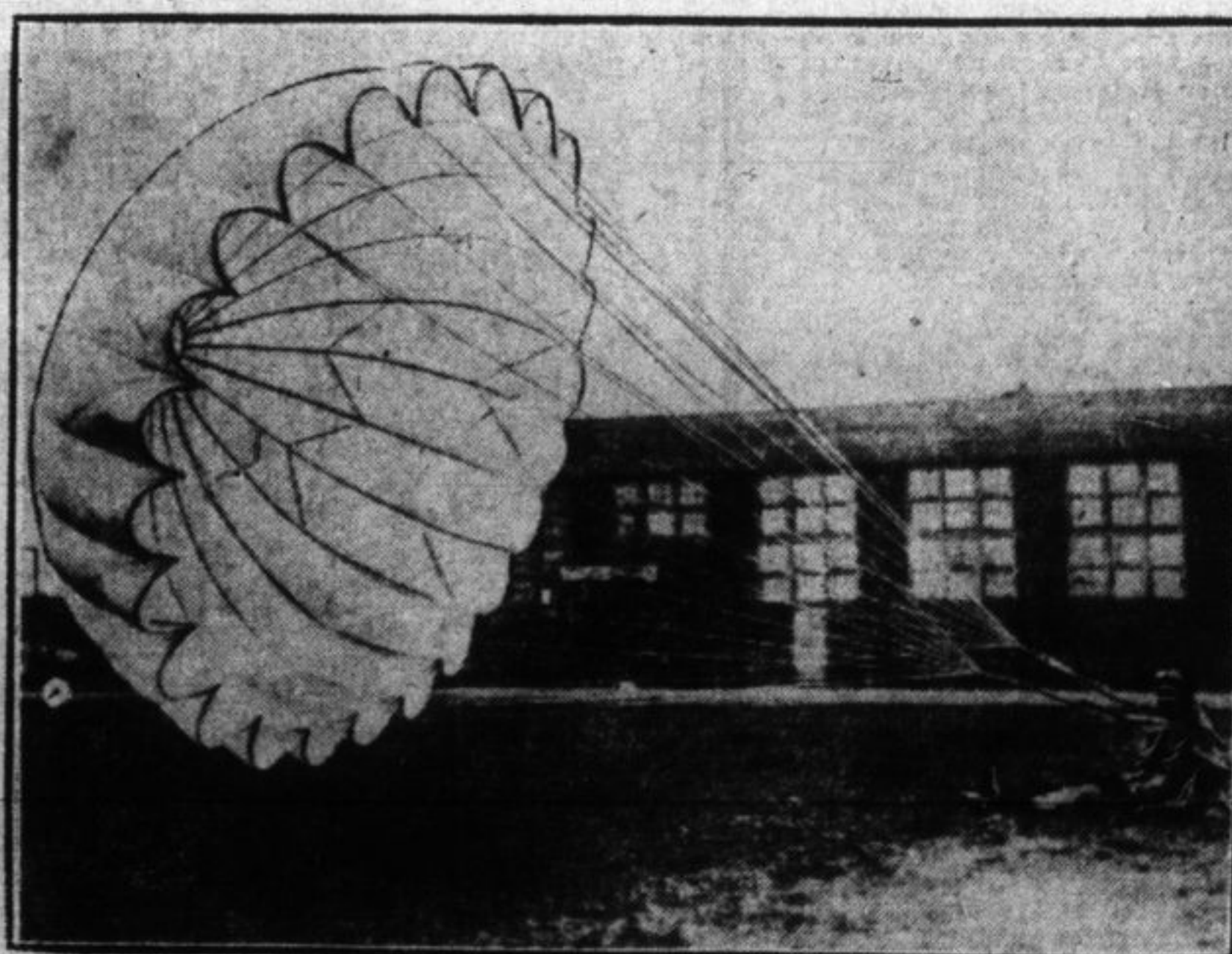
Representative Lister Hill, of Alabama, who is 28 years of age, claims the distinction of being the youngest representative in the 68th session of the House of Representatives
