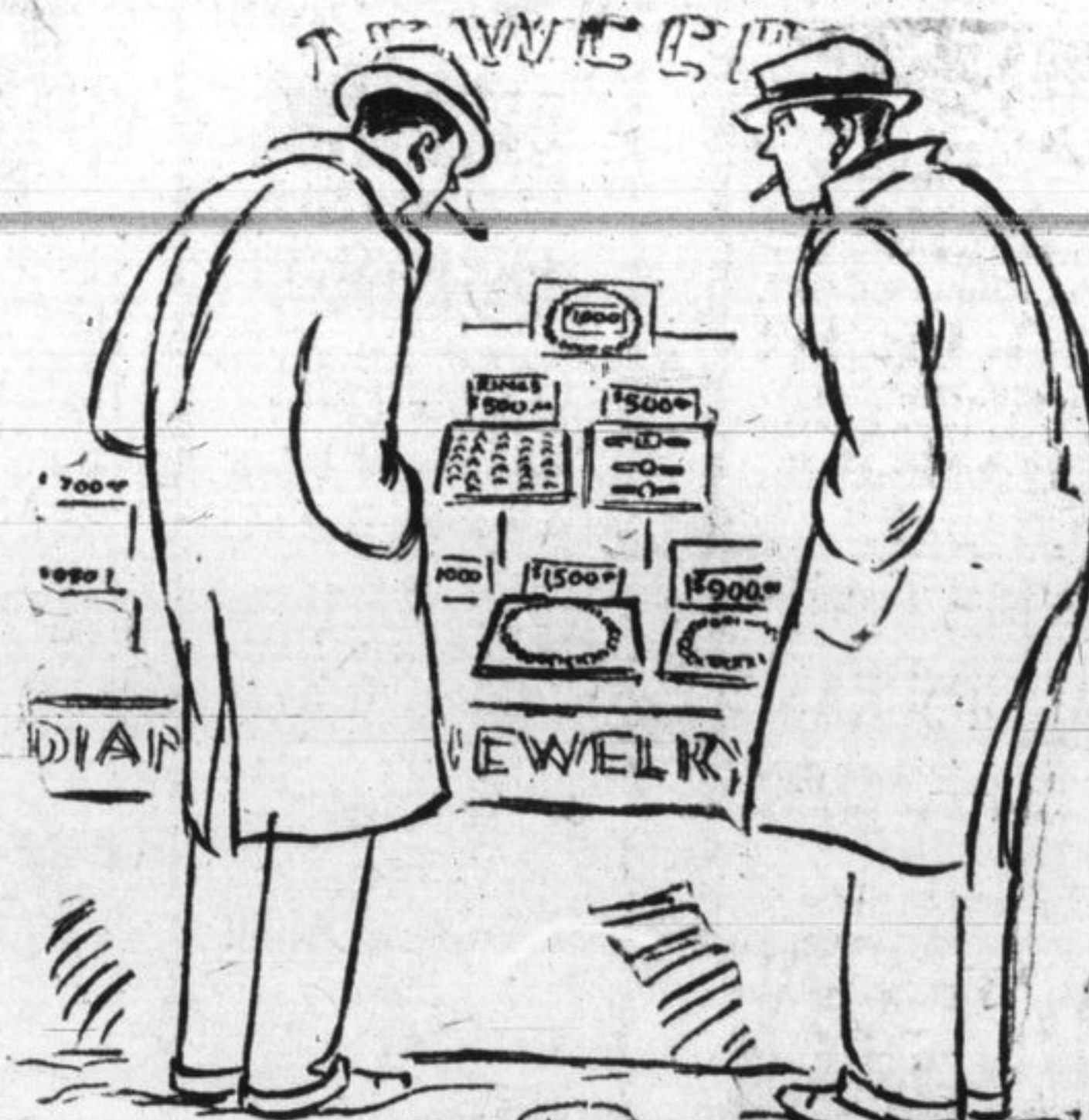

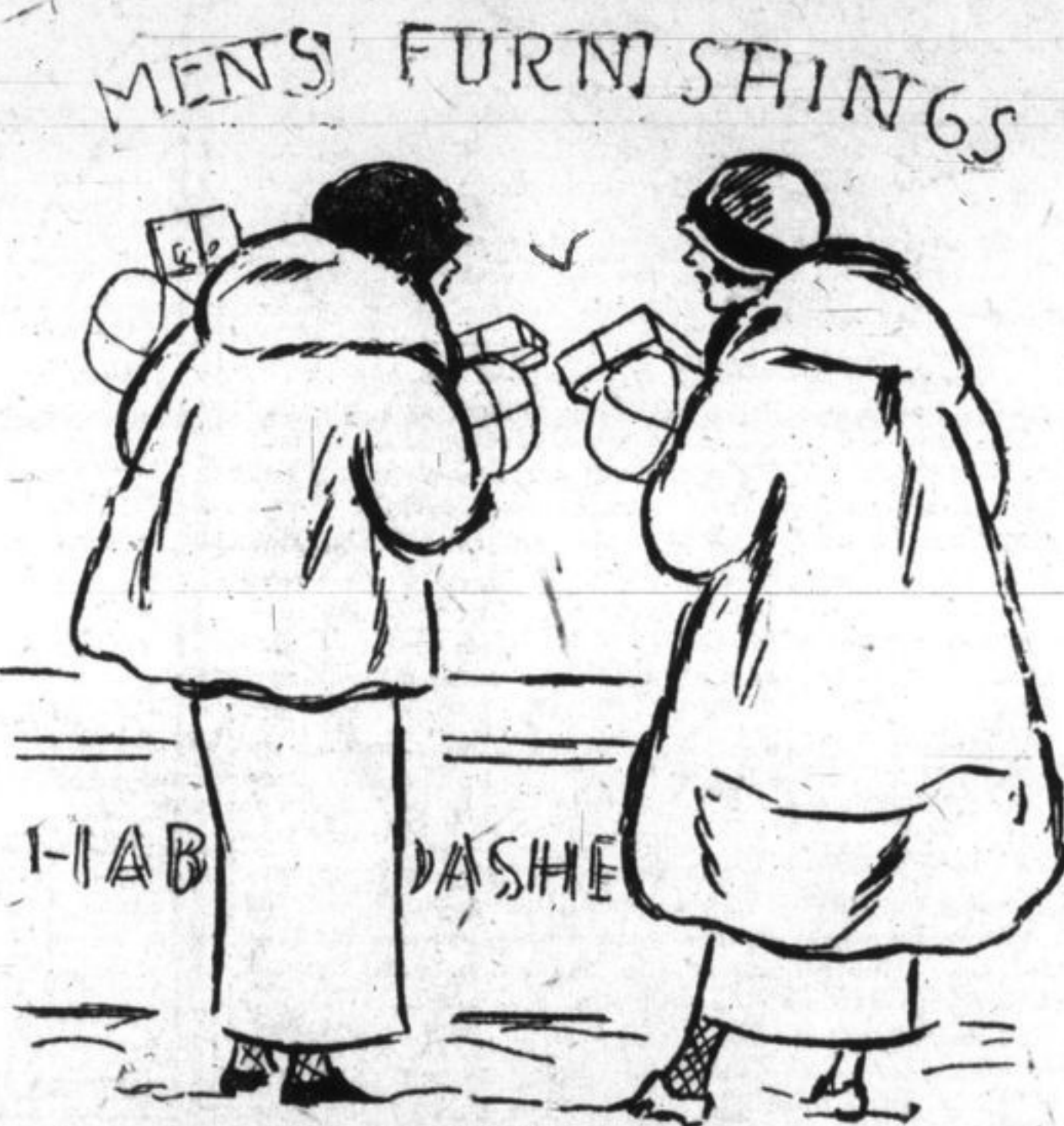

"Gee, but it's hard to select a present for a man who thinks smoking is effeminate."



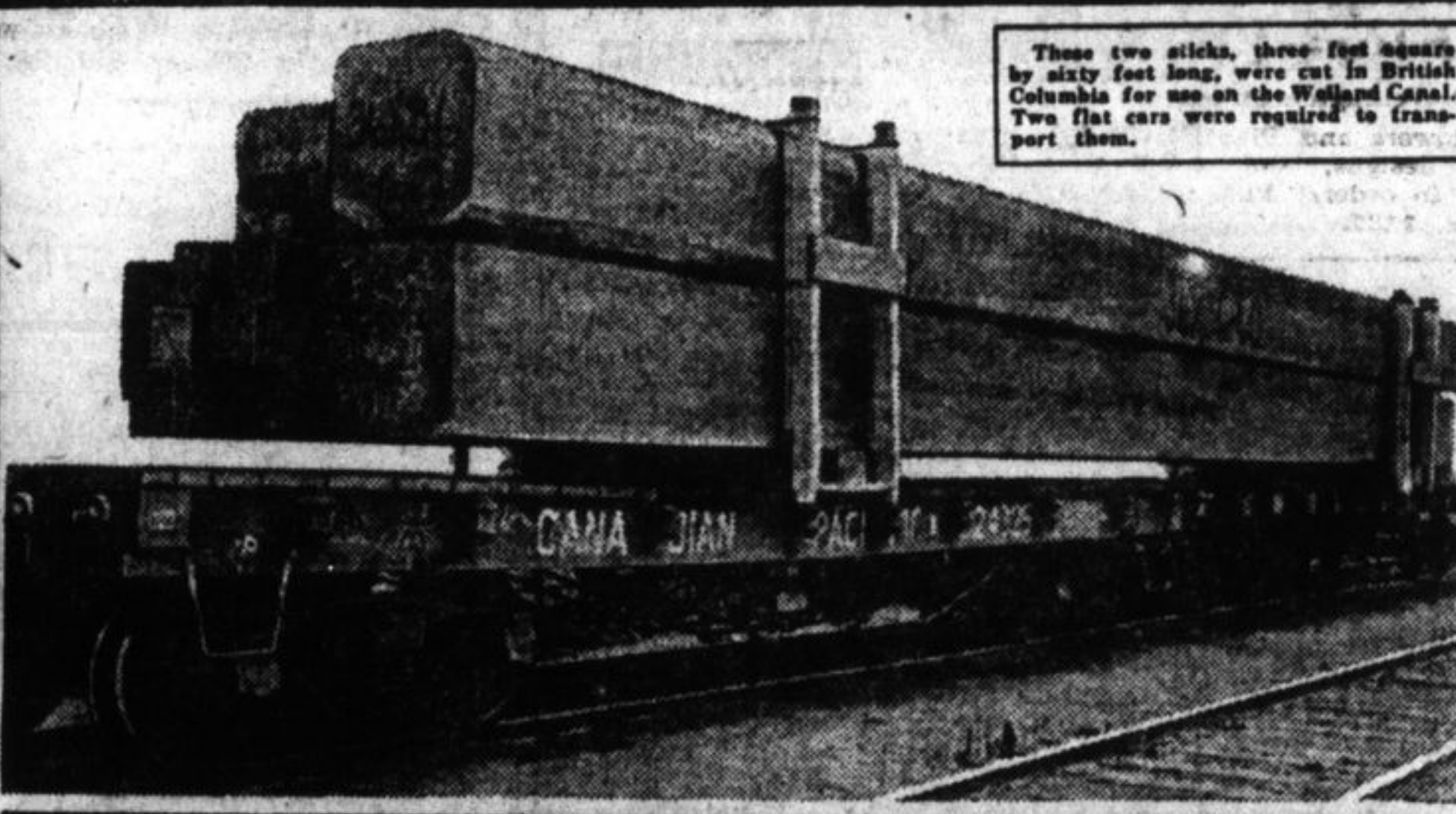
"Oh, what'll I do! I left my money at home."

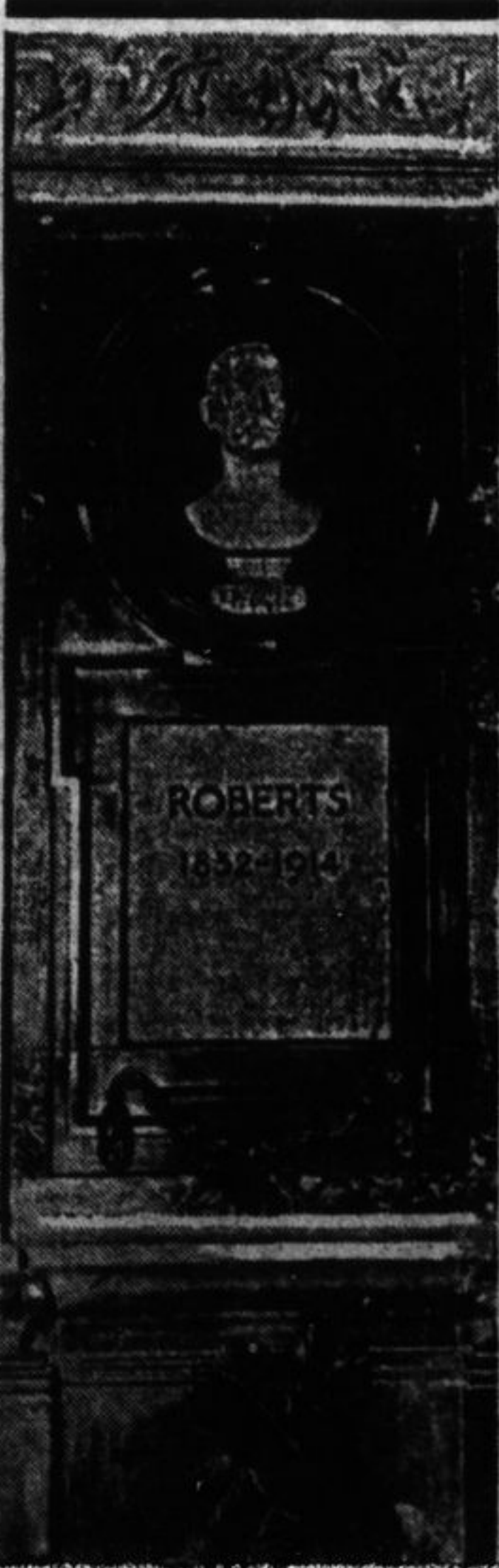

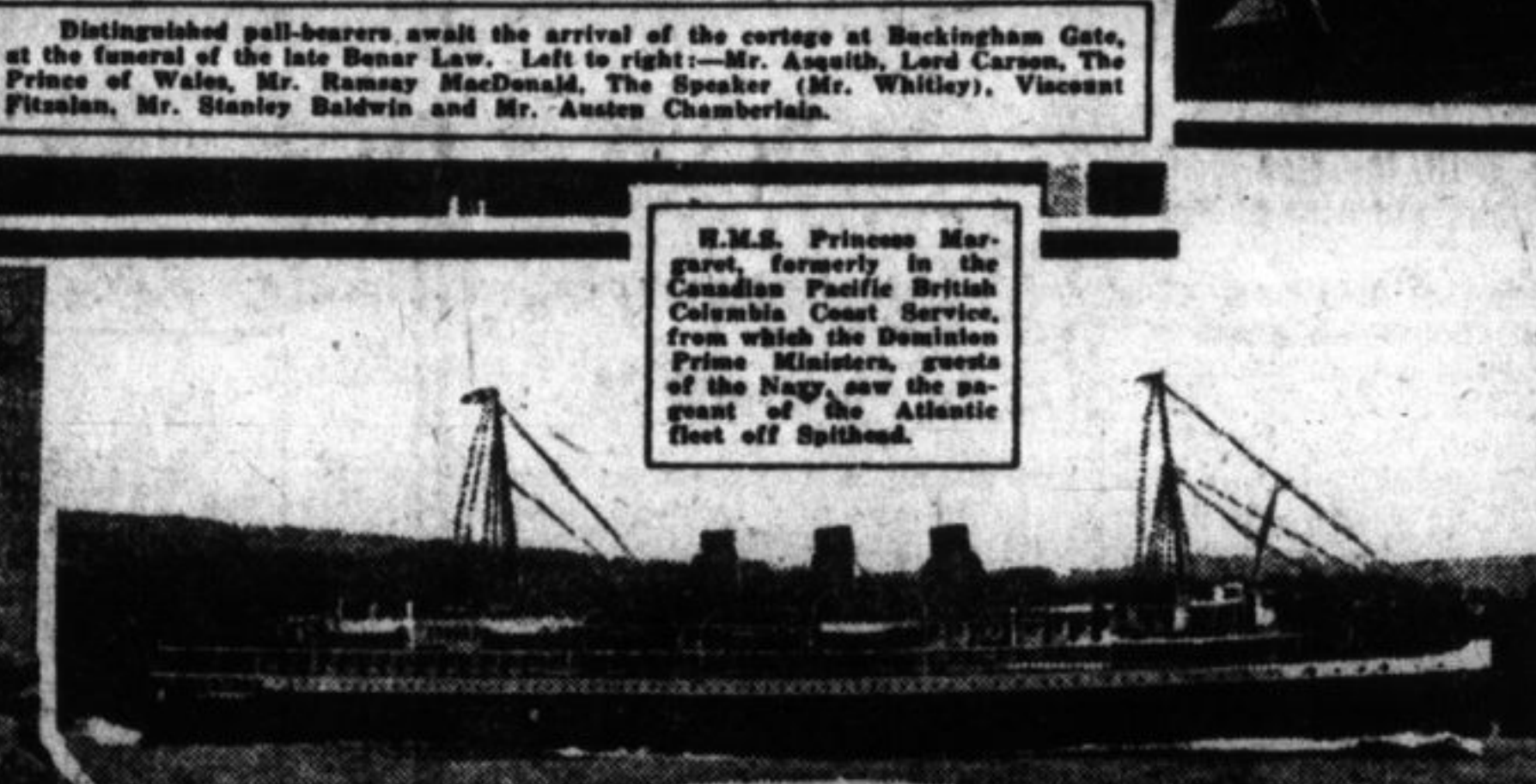
These two arches, those that signify by sixty feet long, were cut in British Columbia for use on the Welland Canal. Two flat cars were required to transport them.
