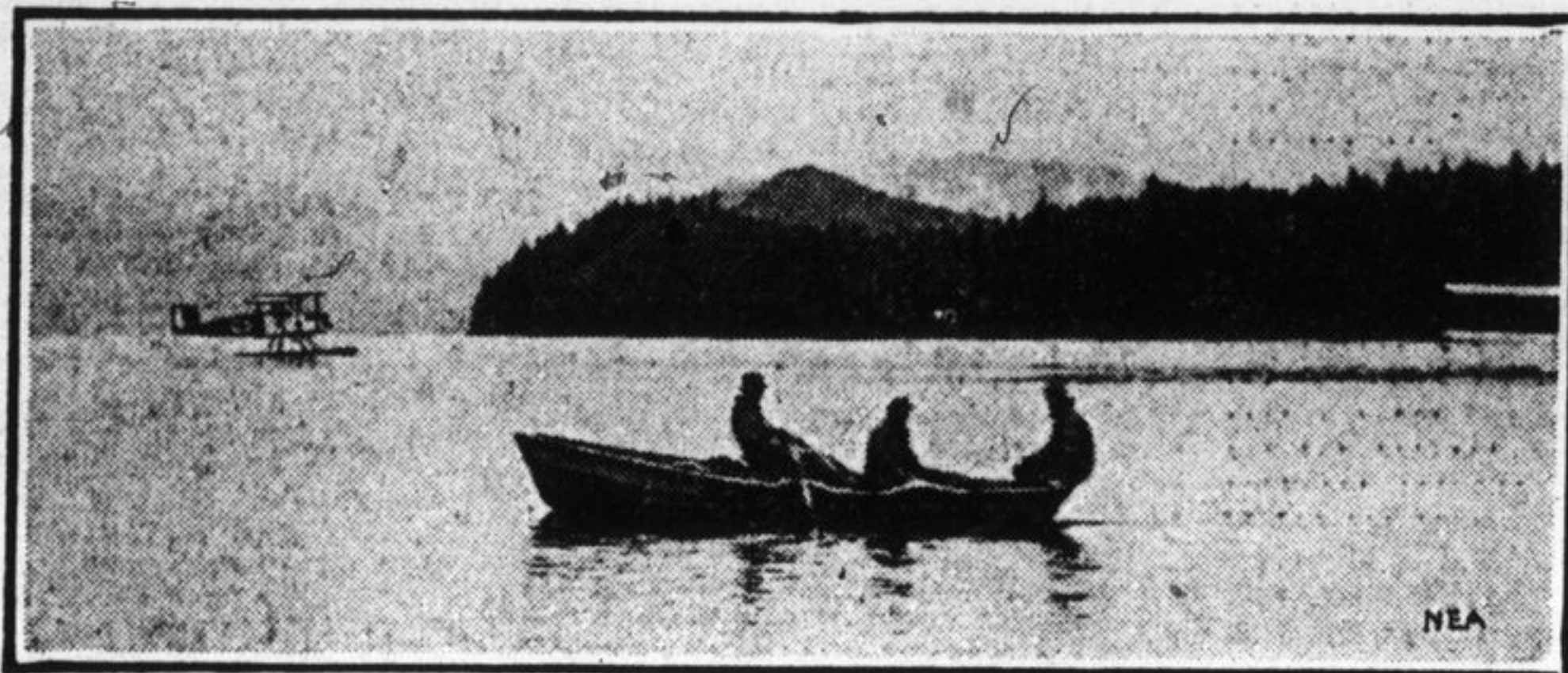


# FIRST PICTURES: PLANES IN ALASKA.
