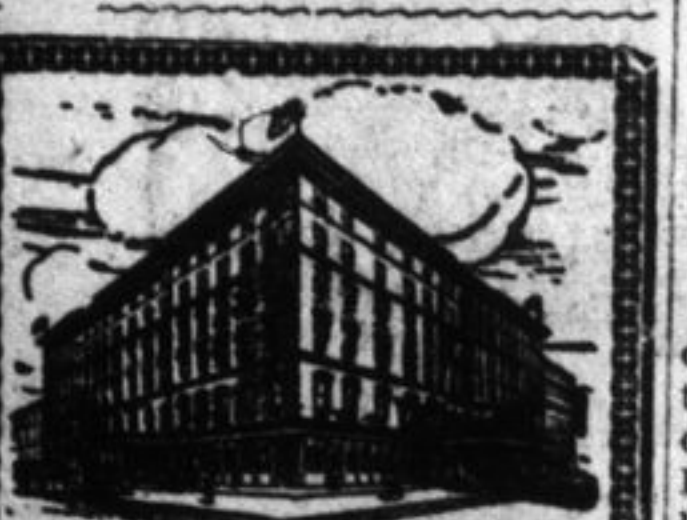

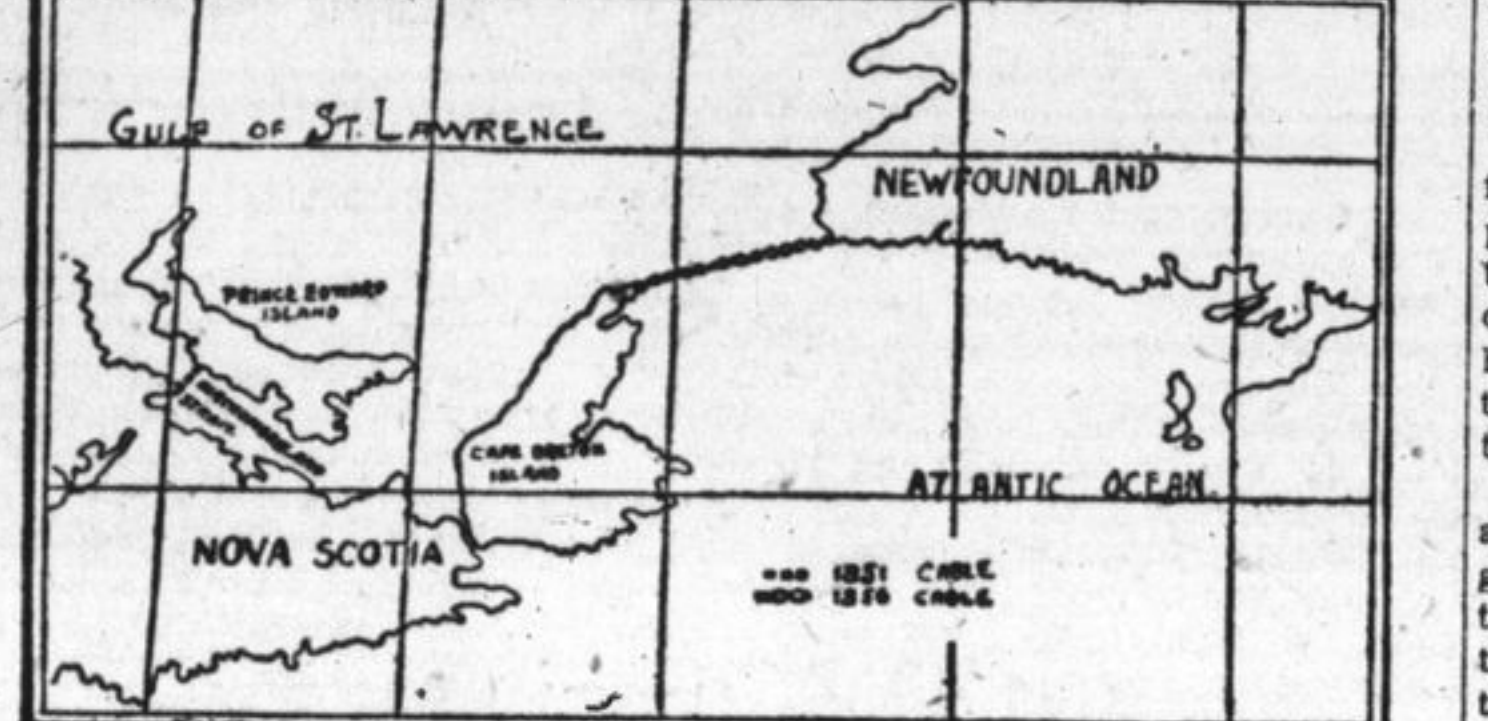


Prince George Hotel TORONTO In Centre of Shopping and Business District

A LONDON LETTER

London, April 24.—The opening of the British Empire Exhibition by the King on April 23rd was without doubt the finest spectacle seen in England since the coronation, nearly thirteen years ago.

Royalty Arrives. A few minutes after eleven the Prince of Wales, president of the exhibition, drove into the arena and was received by the Duke of Devonshire, the whole audience rising to cheer and wave its hats and handkerchiefs.

Exhibition Declared Open. The Prince of Wales read his official request that the king would declare the exhibition open, standing before his father's throne-like chair, in admiral's uniform.
