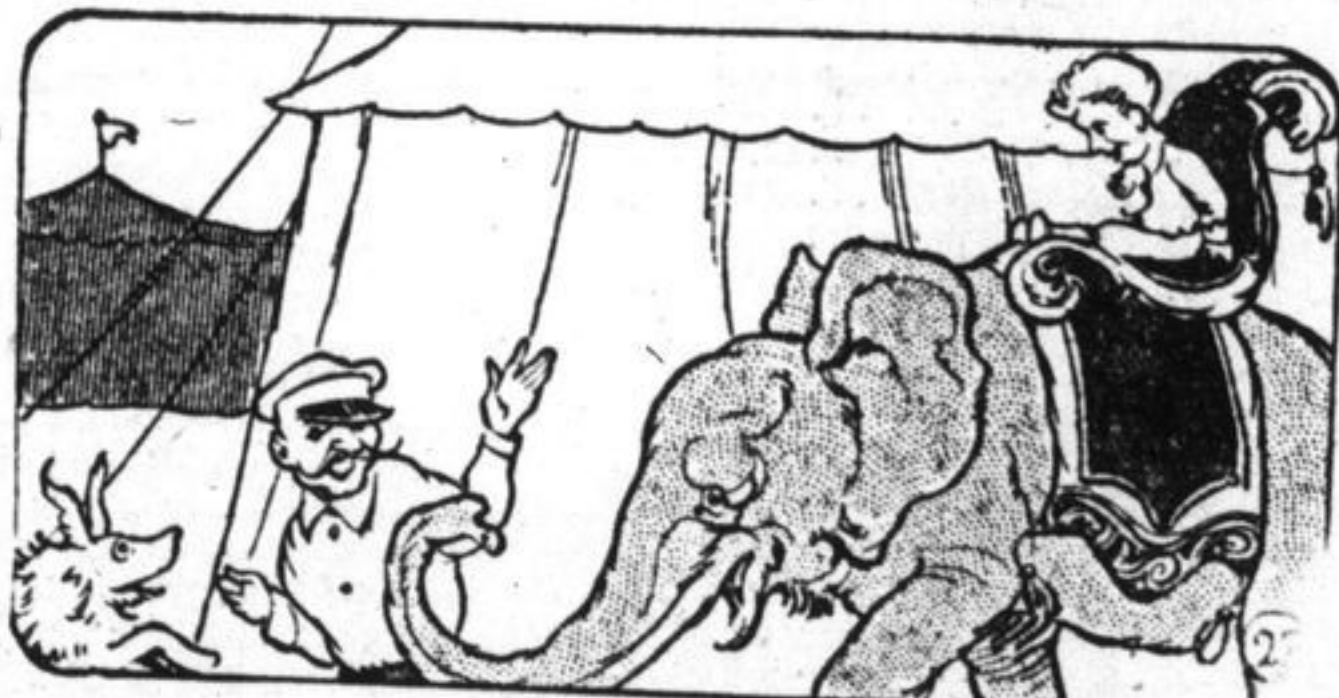
**Under the Circus Tent**



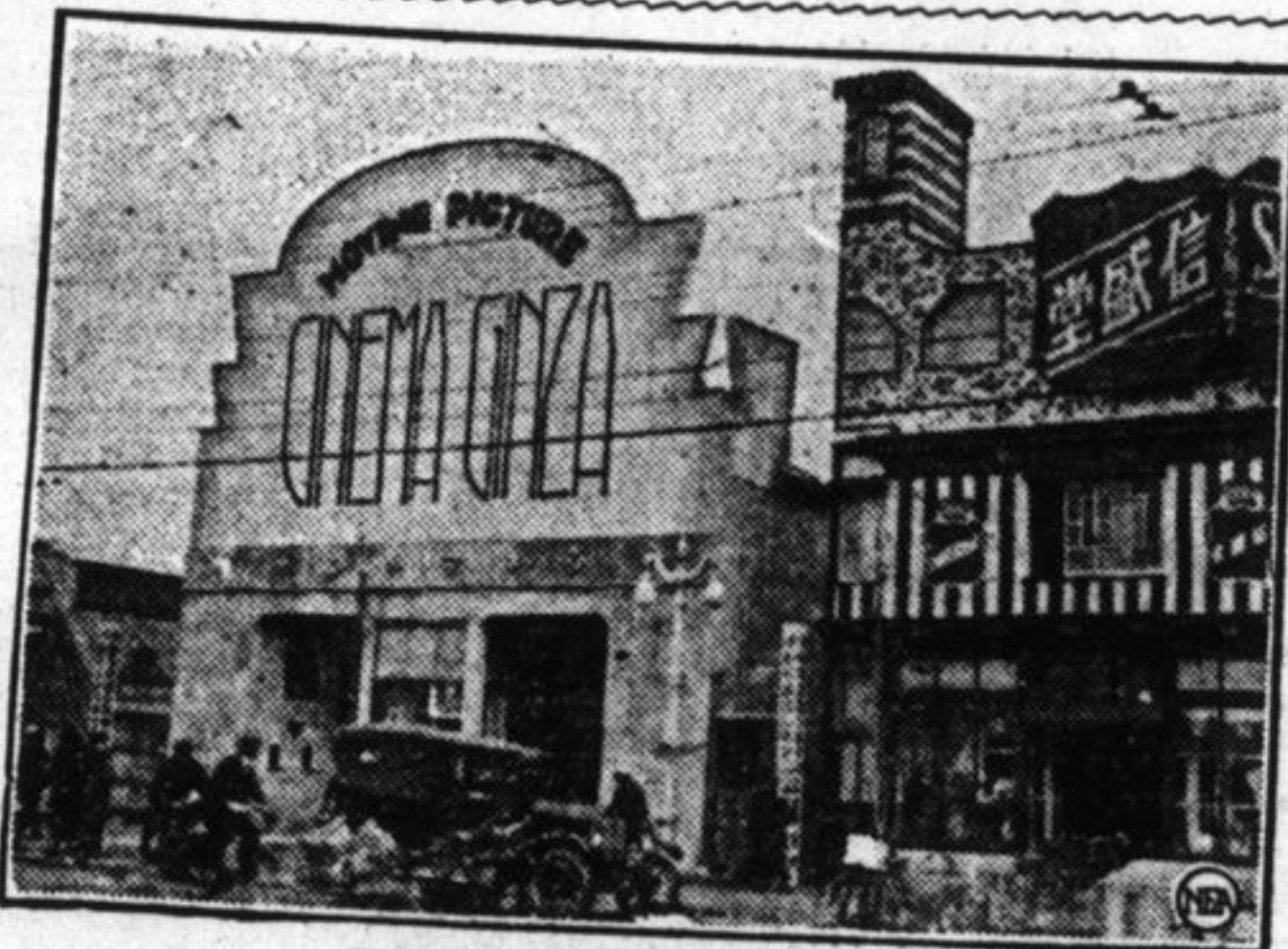
