WHERE CANCER CURE WAS EFFECTED

"One of the rarest cases in medical history" is what noted scientists are terming the complete cure of Miss Celia Trubisz, who was considered an incurable cancer case two years ago. The cure was effected through the combined use of radium and X-rays developed from a new machine capable of 200,000 volts. Dr. Killiam H. Trade with Australia. Australia is a country well worth cultivating from a commercial point of view. Her imports have increased more than 50 per cent. in the past ten years and her exports over 38 per cent. Her imports per capita were \$98.92 in 1922, and were exceeded only New Zealand and the Netherlands. Canada's were \$86.72. Her exports in the same year were \$100.96 per capita, and were exceeded only by New Zealand. Canada's were \$100.63. The difficulty in working up a large trade with the Commonwealth has been that Aus-

tralia has so few products which Canada requires. We could probably take more dried fruit, and there is a standing offer on the Canadian statute book of preference on raisins and currants. This can be brought into effect at any time by order-in-council.—Vancouver Province.

Execute Leases at Once.

The government of Ontario should at once exercise its right of ownership of the waters of the St. Lawrence and the bed of the river by giving the Hydro-Electric commis-

sion a lease of the land and waters required for the Morrisburg development. If the dominion desires that facilities shall be provided for navigation in connection with the power dam, the way will remain open for the adaptation of the power plants to that end. But there must be no indefinite postponement of the power project until the public opinion of Montreal veers round in favor of canal deepening. That may prove a slow process. Ontario is in a position to act at once on the power issue, and to act decisively.—Toronto Globe.
