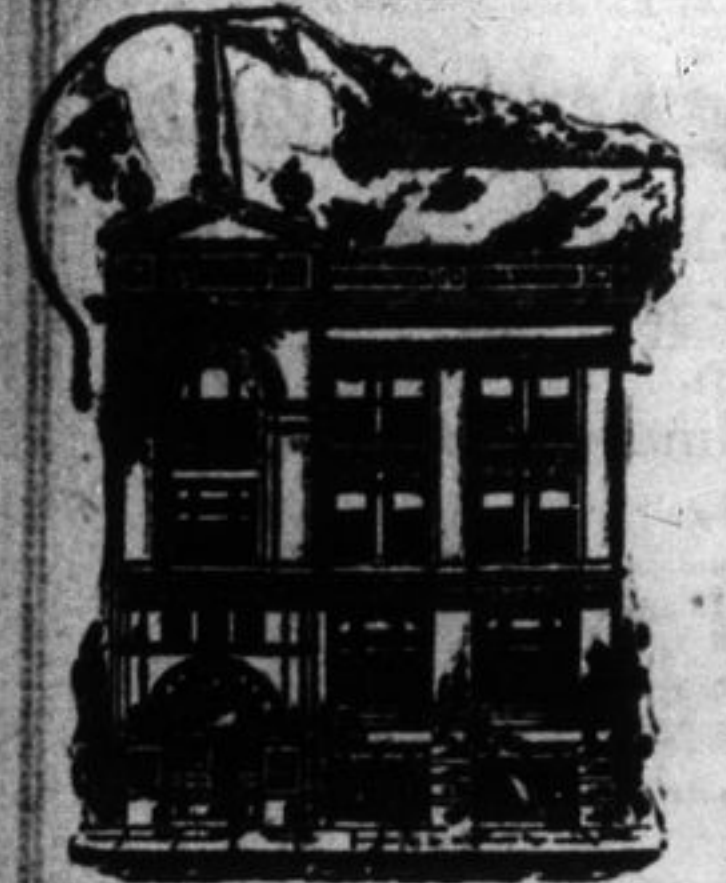

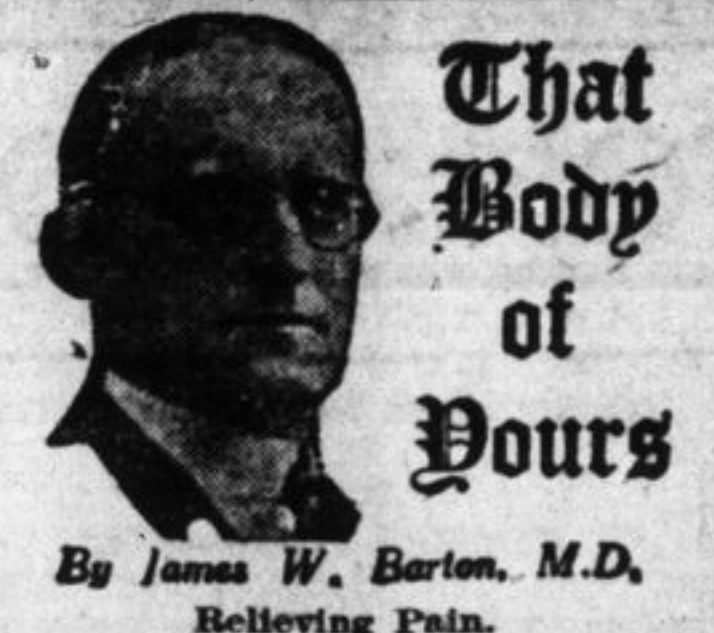
Canada's Story Day by Day
