She was the daughter of Mrs. Kate Parker, Alexandria Bay, and was a life resident of that village. Deceased was telephone operator in the village prior to her marriage in January, 1923.

Good Sale of Sheep.

results. Their three cars of uniform well graded lambs were greatly admired and won an increase of fifty cents per hundred pounds over the top price paid for other best lambs on the market for that day.

Captured Big Fish.

Mrs. Thaw succeeded in landing a masco, which weighed 45 1-4 pounds. The bequest is in the shape of a first mortgage gold bond, Westinghouse Building, and draws interest at the rate of six per cent, payable semi-annually. 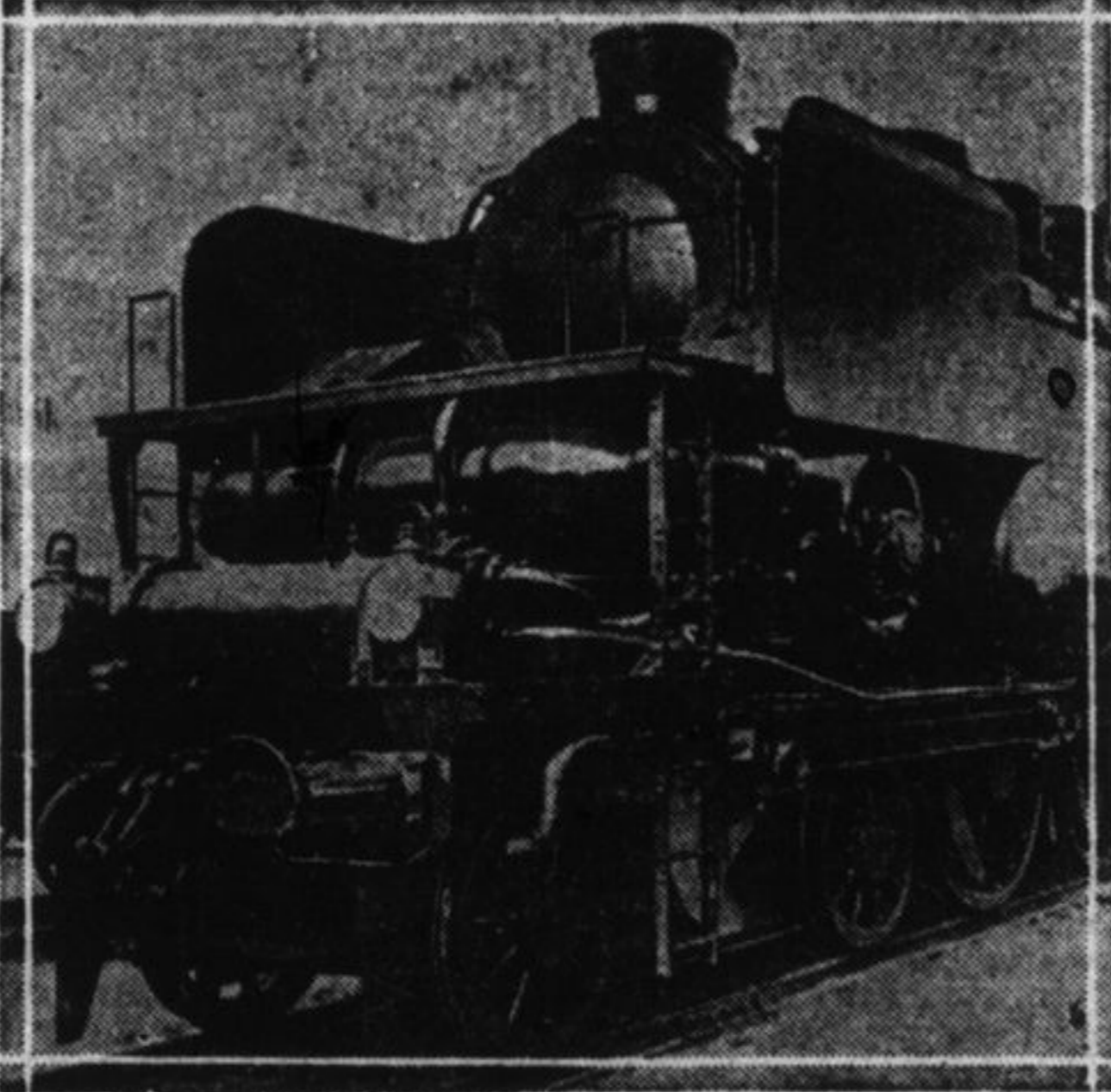
