Accident Award Appealed. The case of Mrs. Jessie Hodges and Dr. J. E. Ayles, as next friend for his son Clifford, against the C.N.R., disposed of at the spring session of the assizes in Cobourg; has been appealed by the railway company, against whom a verdict for heavy damages was awarded. Mrs. Hodges had a son killed over a year ago. The jury awarded Mrs. Hodges \$5,000 and Ayles, \$2,800. The father was allowed \$1,100 for the loss of his truck and for medical attendance for his son.
