LACK OF PROPER FOOD IS AN AID TO DISEASE GERMS.

BY DR. HUGH S. CUMMING. Surgeon General United States Public Health Service. In very early times it was observed that tuberculosis was more apt to occur at certain ages and under certain conditions of living.

The relation of early infection to tuberculosis in later life is important. It is believed that most people are infected before the age of sixteen.

It is most frequent among the poor because they cannot avoid fatigue nor nurse minor ailments nor escape other diseases which predispose to infection.

The poverty stricken worker, the struggling student, the religious recluse, the rote and the ronder, the dissolute spendthrift, the miser, the ascetic, the chronically tired business man, and the over amused society girl, are predisposed to tuberculosis through unwise or unworthy exhaustion of physical resources.

The first predisposing cause of tuberculosis is lack of proper food. In the average American home too little time is given to the study of children's diet during the first ten years of child life, and even when food is properly prepared for children it must not be forgotten that it often takes time and patience to induce a playful, active child to eat proper things in sufficient quantity and at the proper time.

The child who refuses at table whole some articles of food such as bread and butter, vegetables and meat, cannot maintain a satisfactory degree of nourishment.

Tuberculosis is Contagious. At the present time there are many people who still do not know that tuberculosis is contagious and because of this lack of knowledge do not take precautions.

The anti-spitting laws now existing in most cities deserve to be backed by a strong public sentiment.

The viciously careless consumptive who daily exposes his family or neighbors to disease should be put under proper institutional control. It is dangerous to house young children with consumptives but it would be difficult
