SIR R. P. HOUSTON DEAD. Was Head of Line of Steamers Bear in His Name. Liverpool, April 15.—Sir Robert Paterson Houston, ex-M.P., ship owner, head of the Houston Line of steamers, died yesterday. He was 73 years of age. For 32 years Sir Robert was Conservative member of the House of Commons for the West Toxteth division of Liverpool, but he was defeated in the last general election by J. Gibbons, the Labor candidate.
