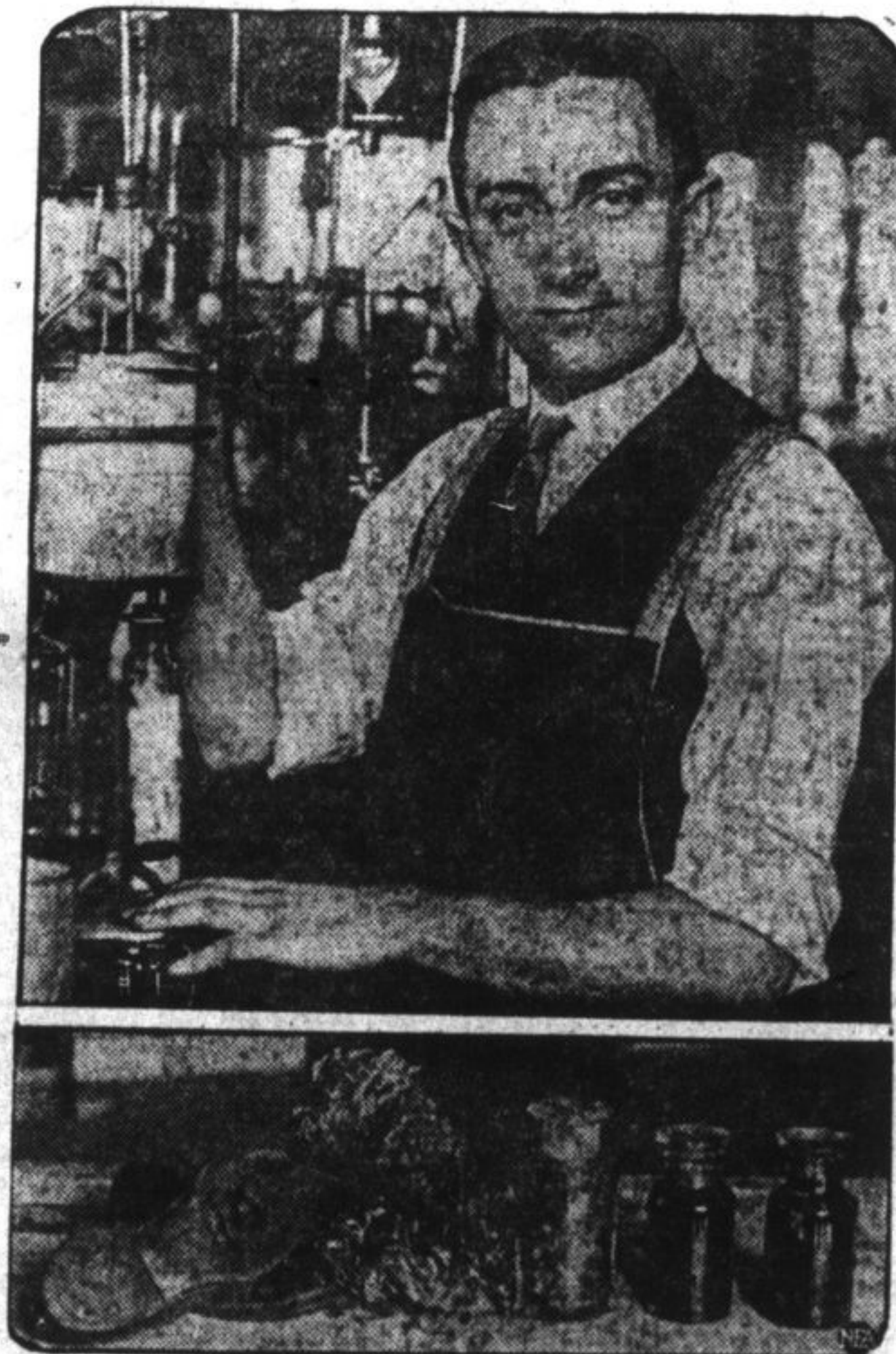
### COUNT SALM AT CANNES

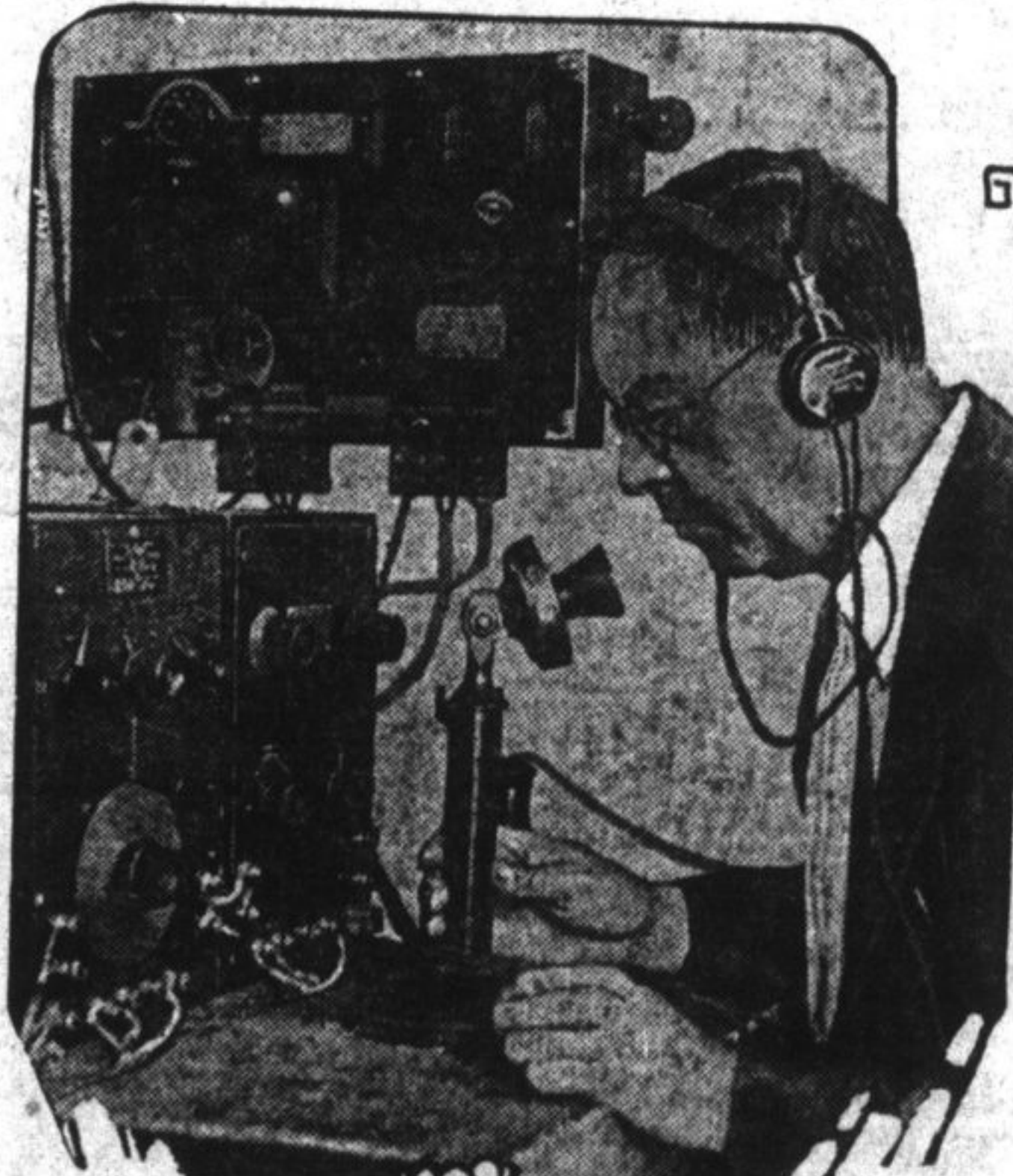
### THE DUFFER
