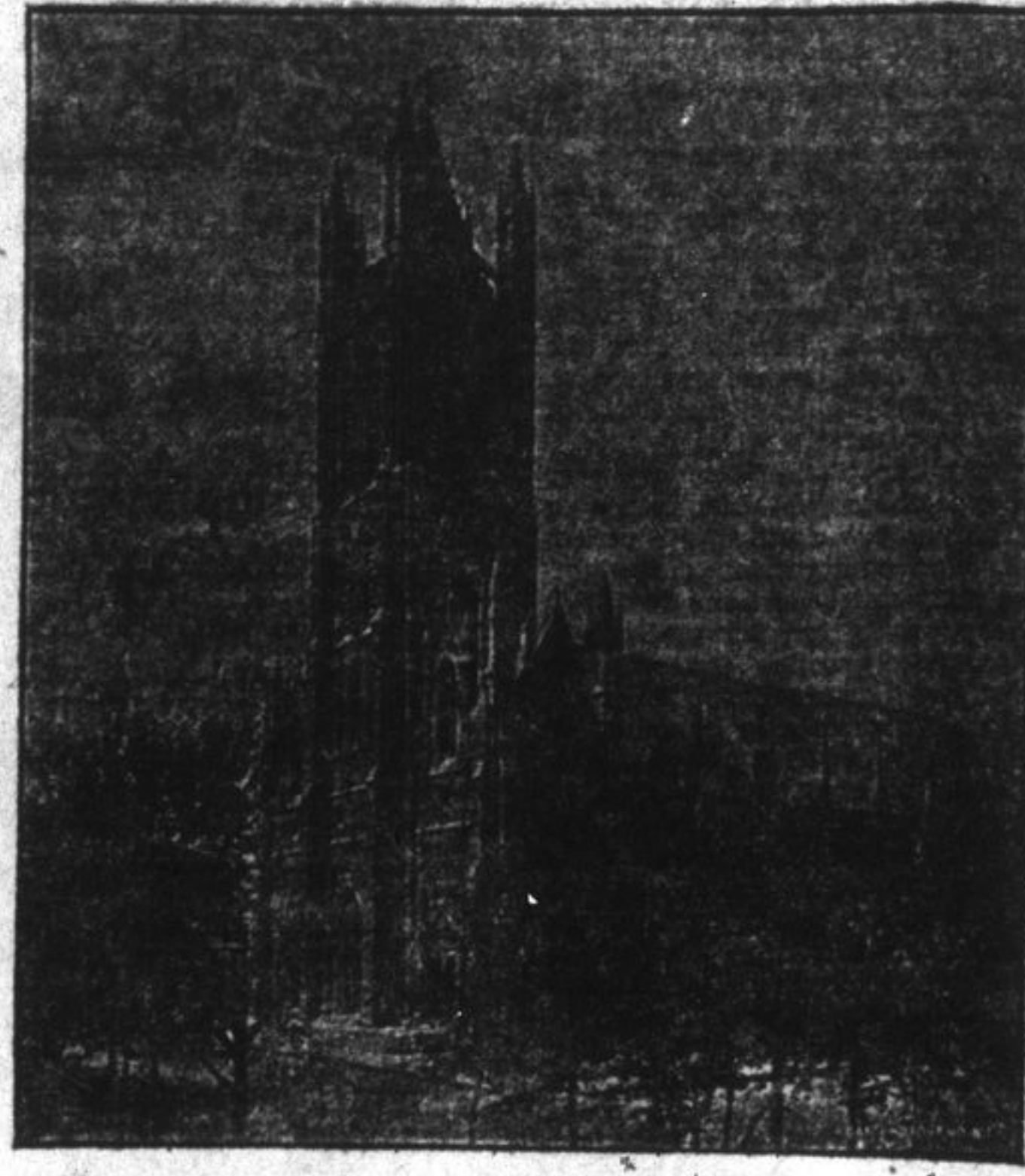

## The Bishops and Archbishops Who Have Presided Over Diocese of Kingston During Past 100 Years



**RIGHT REVEREND ALEXANDER MacDONELL, D.D.**  
Came to Canada 1803 with large contingent of Highland Scottish Catholics; appointed Vicar-General of district 1817; consecrated Bishop 1820; appointed first Bishop 1820; appointed first Bishop of Kingston on founding of Diocese, January 27, 1826; founded College of Iona in Glengarry and first Catholic newspaper in English in Canada; at Kingston founded Regiopolis College and laid foundations of the Church in Ontario as it is today; died January 14th, 1840.

**MOST REV. JAMES VINCENT CLEARY, D.D.**  
Consecrated in Rome, Nov. 21st., 1880; appointed Archbishop July 29th, 1889; died Feb. 24th, 1898; built the beautiful tower on the Cathedral; constructed St. James Chapel; revived Regiopolis College.



**RIGHT REVEREND REMIGIUS GAULIN, D.D.**  
Consecrated Bishop Oct. 20th, 1838; appointed to Kingston, January 14th, 1840; during his regime Diocese of Toronto founded 1841 and Diocese of Ottawa, 1848; commenced building of the beautiful Cathedral Church of the Immaculate Conception; brought to Kingston the sisters of the Congregation de Notre Dame and the Religious Hospitaliers of St. Joseph; died May 8th, 1857.



**RIGHT REV. EDWARD JOHN HORAN, D.D.**  
Consecrated May 1, 1858; died Feb. 15th, 1875; ruled the Diocese for seventeen years and continued much of the work instituted by Bishops Gaulin and Phelan.



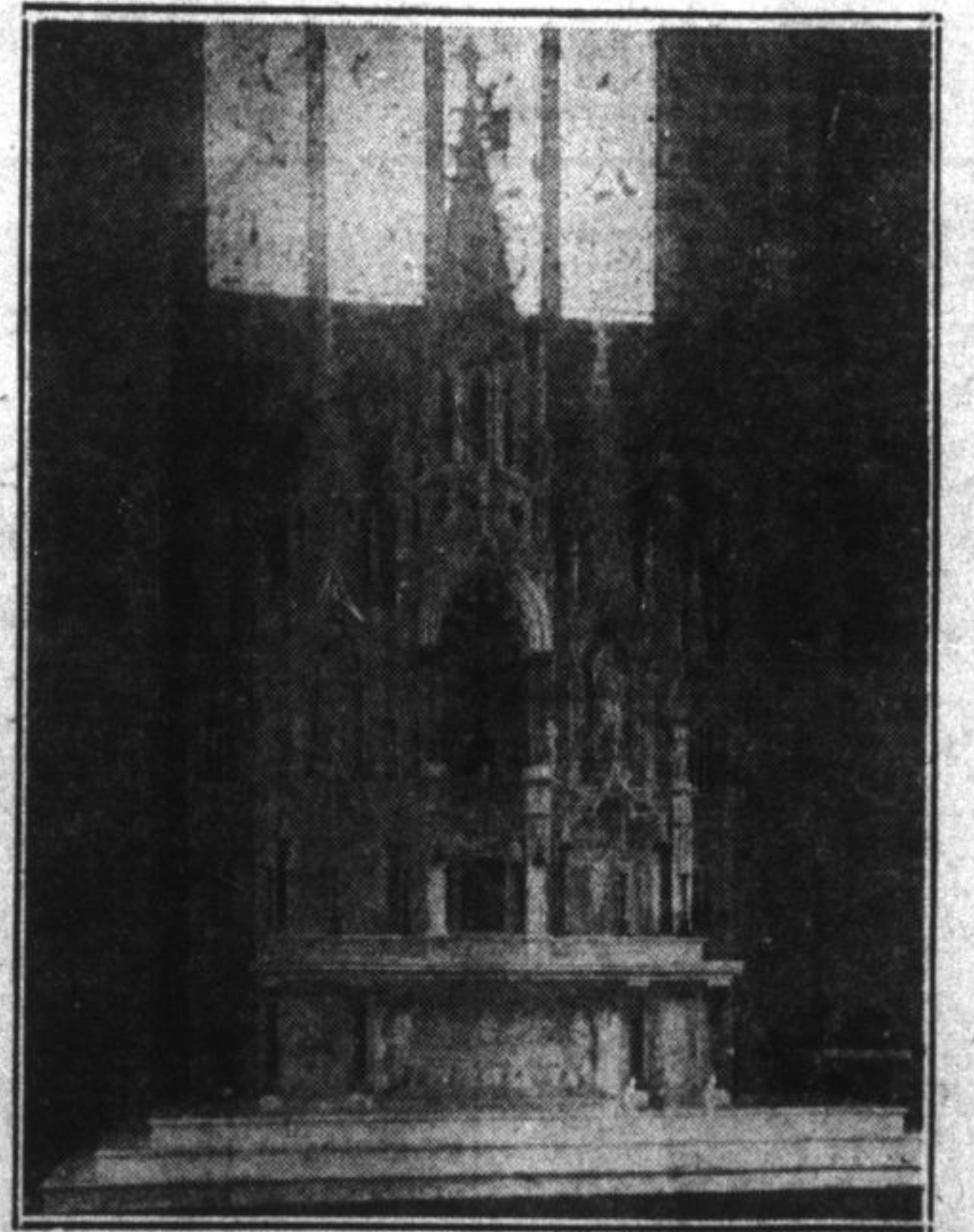
**RIGHT REV. JOHN O'BRIEN, D.D.**  
Consecrated April 18, 1875; died August 1, 1879; born at Halton, Ontario; ruled for four years.



**MOST REV. CHARLES HUGH GAUTHIER, D.D.**  
Consecrated Archbishop of Kingston, Oct. 18th, 1896; transferred to Ottawa, Sept. 6th, 1910; died January 19th, 1922; during his regime the splendid organ of the Cathedral was installed, the new marble altar constructed and the entire interior of the church redecored, including the magnificent paintings of the Immaculate Conception and the Assumption.



**RIGHT REVEREND PATRICK PHELAN, S.S., D.D.**  
Consecrated May 20, 1843; appointed administrator of diocese in 1852; appointed Bishop May 8, 1857; died less than a month after, June 6th, 1857.

**MOST REV. M. J. SPRATT, D.D.**  
The present Archbishop; appointed while parish priest of Belleville and consecrated Nov. 30th, 1911; has cleared the Cathedral of an immense debt and placed Kingston parish and many others in the diocese on a sound business basis; sponsored the transfer of The Canadian Freeman to the control of the Church; commenced building up Regiopolis College and has developed it to its present status; encouraged religious vocations among the young men of the diocese by establishing a Seminary Fund; as a result of this in the neighborhood of thirty priests have been ordained from the Archdiocese during His Grace's regime; the Separate Schools throughout the city have been much improved, Catholic Charities have been organized under one head and the Church in all its branches is in a flourishing condition.
