Kingston Industrial Fair Opens Tuesday

The Kingston Industrial Exhibition opens on Tuesday with every indication pointing to the fact that it will out-class any previous fair put on in Eastern Ontario excepting only the Central Canada Exhibition. The president, manager and directors of the Exhibition have been devoting a great deal of time and attention to providing new attractions and they are satisfied that their patrons will be highly pleased with the entertainment features and educational exhibits arranged for.

Individual entries are this year larger than ever before and although the number has increased, the quality is quite up to the usual mark. Kingston Exhibition has for many years prided itself on its livestock, industrial, grain, domestic, fancy work, dairy, automobile and retail exhibits and officials of the fair have assured the Whig that during the coming exhibition these exhibits will attain proportions never before achieved.

For the amusement of young and old there will be a first-class mid-way providing entertainment of the better class. All the old time mid-way favorites such as Aunt Sally, Ring the Bell, the merry-go-round, the Ferris wheel, the shooting gallery will be on the grounds as well as a score of the very newest types of attractions direct from the big-est fairs in Canada and the United States. Besides the regular mid-way shows there will be special attractions in front of the grand stand.

Trials of speed, always a big attraction at the Kingston Exhibition, will this year be featured and the management has learned that the substantial prizes offered are attracting many of the very best horses in this section of the country. The Kingston track is acknowledged by horsemen to be one of the best and these speed trials should provide a real thrill for the spectators. Perhaps the greatest educational exhibit ever shown at any fair, the public health exhibit, will doubtless attract a great deal of attention when displayed here next week under the auspices of the Mental Hygiene Council, the Social Hygiene Council, the Tuberculosis Association and the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company in conjunction with the social service clubs of Kingston. This exhibit is calculated to show the layman the havoc wrought by the great economic diseases and the latest methods of combating them. Moving pictures, models, posters and free literature will all play an important part in this exhibit.

For the past week work has been going forward at the Exhibition grounds getting the buildings in shape for the exhibit, erecting new stands, repairing and improving until now everything is in readiness to receive the exhibits which will be placed on Monday and Tuesday.
