EXPORT OF CHEESE LARGEST OF SEASON

Shipment of Cheese Over 21,-000 Boxes in Excess of Previous Week.

Montreal, Sept. 22 .- The exports of butter from the port of Montreal last week were 8,923 packages which show a decrease of 8,520 packages, as compared with the previous week. and a decrease of 8,491 packages with the same week last year, while the total shipments for the season to date have been 180,893 packages less than the same period of 1925.

The movement of cheese for export account last week was the largest of any previous week this season to date, the shipments being 75,-551 boxes, which showed an increase of 21,027 boxes, as compared with the previous one, and an increase of 5,405 boxes with the same week last year, but the total for the season to date shows a decrease of 143,973 boxes with the same period a year
