

MILITIA PENSION AGENT'S OFFICE—YORK, 18th September, 1816.

NOTICE is hereby given by the General Agent for the Payment of Militia Provincial Pensions, pursuant to the directions contained in the Seventh Section of the Militia Pension Act, passed in the last Session of the Legislature, that having received the Sum of Six Thousand Five Hundred Pounds, for the purpose of paying the said Pensions for the period up to the 31st of December next, the same are now in Course of Payment.

LIST of disabled Persons who have heretofore been admitted, and of those also who claim to be admitted, as Militia Pensioners of this Province, on account of Wounds received in Action, or Disability occasioned by Casualties or Accidents which have occurred on Actual Service in defence of the Province, as far as Returns have been received; with the sums due to those who have produced the necessary Certificates and Documents touching their Wounds and Disability; and which will be due to others who have produced those Documents in part, when they will have furnished their complete, as required by Law, up to the 31st of December, 1816.
