At a meeting of the President and Trustees of the Midland District School Society, held on Tuesday the 25th August, 1818—The following Resolutions was passed, and ordered to be Published.

Resolved, 1st That admittance to the School be by an annual Subscription of £200 Currency, for each Scholar, payable quarterly, in advance, to the Treasurer, who will give a ticket of admission; without which no scholar shall be admitted.—

2d. That after the 14th day of Sept. the School shall be conducted solely on the British System.

3d. That the President & Trustees do each have the charge or inspection of the school for one week, and that they or he shall visit it at least one day in the week.

4th. That Quarterly examinations of the pupils be held (due notice thereof, having been previously given by the society in the Kingston Gazette.) on the 1st Saturday of January, April, July and October, in each and every year. 15w2
