PROCLAMATION.

UPPER CANADA.

F. B. HEAD, Lieutenant Governor.

WILLIAM the FOURTH, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c. &c.

To our beloved and faithful Legislative Councillors of our Province of Upper Canada, and to our Knights, Citizens and Burgesses of our said Province; to our Provincial Parliament at our City of Toronto, on the twenty-seventh day of October, instant, to be commenced, held, called and elected, and to every of you—

WHEREAS by our Proclamation bearing date the fifteenth day of September last, we thought fit to prorogue our Provincial Parliament to the twenty seventh day of October, instant, at which time at our City of Toronto you were held and constrained to appear.

NOW KNOW YE, that we taking into our Royal consideration the ease and convenience of our loving Subjects, have thought fit, by and with the advice of our Executive Council to relieve you and each of you of your attendance at the time aforesaid, hereby convoking, and by these presents enjoining you and each of you, that on Tuesday, the Eighth day of November, next ensuing, you meet us in our Provincial Parliament, at our City of Toronto, FOR THE ACTUAL DISPATCH OF PUBLIC BUSINESS, there to take into consideration the state and welfare of our said Province of Upper Canada, and therein to do as may seem necessary, and herein fail not.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these our Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of our said Province to be hereunto affixed—WITNESS our trusty and well beloved SIR FRANCIS BOND HEAD, K. C. H. &c. &c. Lieutenant Governor of our said Province, this Sixth day of October, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-six, and in the seventh year of our Reign.
