NOTICE. — To amend certain parts of the Act relating to the Harbor of the City of Kingston, and for other purposes.

[Passed Wednesday, April 26, 1848.]

WHEREAS, it is expedient to amend certain parts of the "Habor Act, and to impose Harbor Dues on Wood Boats, and to charge the Market charges on vehicles laden with fire wood;—

It is therefore enacted by the City Council of the City of Kingston,

That so much of "An Act to regulate the Public Market in the City of Kingston," passed on the tenth day of May, A.D. 1847, and eight hundred and forty six, as includes or relates to Schedule A, the said Act, or anything contrary to this Act, be hereby repealed.

11. That the whole of the "Act relating to the Harbor, in the City of Kingston," passed on the twelfth day of October, one thousand and eight hundred and forty six, be now revised and enforced, except that the rates, charges or dues mentioned in so much of the Schedule of the said Act as is placed under the head of "Sailing Vessels" and "Rafts" shall be hereafter paid by the holders of the amount of dues, and allowance or disallowance of Certificates, be held at the Judge's Chambers, in the Court House, City of Kingston, on FRIDAY, the Nineteenth day of MAY next, at the hour of TWELVE o'clock, noon.
