### LAST NIGHT'S REPORT.

MONTREAL, May 9, 81, P. M.

We have nothing commercial to report. The markets do not appear to have been affected by the Steamer's news.

The regular meeting at the Banque du Maritime Hall, Saturday, was not very much attended. There was probably from 6 to 800 persons present.

The Chair was taken by Mr. Chouin, and the meeting addressed by Messrs. McCoy, Devlin, Brennan, and T. Ryan. A number of resolutions were passed, and the meeting separated with a vote of thanks to the Mayor for the use of the Hall.

### BUFFALO MARKET—May 9.

The sales which fell under our observation were 3000 bushels prime quail; Ohio Wheat in store at \$1.14; 3,500 bushels similar quality at \$1.

15c; 2500 bushels Ohio to arrive by tomorrow at \$1.13c; 2300 bushels Cleveland, and 2000 bushels Nassau to arrive this week at \$1.14c.

2000 bushels of flour in store at \$1.

15c; 1000 bushels of 5000 bushels mixed Michigan and Ohio, at \$5.12c; and 150 bushels extra Michigan at \$5.25c, and 150 bushels extra Ontario at \$5.12c.

Wheat is in great request; every other operation appearing to have an order for purchasing; the stock in the market is very trifling, some 6,000 bushels wheat sold at \$1.14c, and two cargoes to arrive, one of 1000 bushels at \$1.14c.

The grain demand for Corn is still limited supply. Sales 2000 bushels at \$1.35c, and an invoice of 5000 bushels in store at 40c.

Meat Pork is in good request, and butchers have advanced their prices. Sales this morning about 150 bushels Buffalo Inspection at \$3. Pickled Ham and Shoulders in stores are offering at \$3c. and 3c. a lb.

Lard—Offering at \$1.50c. There is a fair supply for High-wines, and we notice the sale of 2000 cases at 15c.

Flour is in great request; partly a number of bales having made their appearance lately. Flour to Albany cannot be quoted to day over \$5.00c.

Specie Wheat \$1.14c; Corn, 12c; Oats, 12c;

and Provision, \$3.25c; and New York Provision and meat at \$6.25c.
