PUBLIC NOTICE! STREET WATERING BY-LAW. DARTIES desirous of having streets watered beyond the district watered by the Corporation are required to send in applications, which must be supported by the signatures of at least two-thirds of the property owners residing in the district applied for.

PUBLIC NOTICE. I hereby give notice to all whom it may concern that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kingston, intending to pass a By-law after the expiration of one month from the date of the publication of this notice, by the 30th day of April, 1887, namely, the 30th day of May, next, at the said Council meeting on that day, if it does not at its next meeting, for the widening of the portion of Young street, or that part of said street generally known as "Little's Lane," extending from the easterly boundary of said street to the westerly boundary of said street, and for appropriating the necessary funds for the said purpose, which funds may be described as follows, that is to say: Commencing at the point where the southerly boundary of said Little's Lane intersects the westerly boundary of said street, and extending southerly to the southerly boundary of said street, a distance of 20 feet 3 inches, more or less to the northerly side of a stone house, there easterly along said southerly boundary of said Little's Lane to the place of beginning and according to a plan of the same on file in the office of the City Engineer, which plan may be seen with the City Engineer, or at the office of any person interested. All persons whose lands or interests are affected by the proposed widening of said street, or the appropriation of funds for the said purpose, are hereby notified that they may be heard by the said Council either in person or by counsel or attorney before passing the said By-law.
