While the Government of Ontario is quite ready to launch out into an expansion of a number of bills on the books, Mr. Maitland has done himself quite unable to do anything for the muskoka officers. The people of the Province would excuse the omission of a little red tape in a case of distress, while they will probably object to extravagance.

A contemporary suggests that the sessions of the local legislature should be shortened to thirty days, according to a statutory provision by which the members are to be paid six dollars per day, including expenses and six hundred dollars for the session. The session would be greatly shortened by applying a respite from legislative tinkering; people would have time to learn what the law was, and a large amount of money would be saved.

Excellencies prevail in Germany consequent upon the intention of the Emperor to make his son, the Crown Prince Frederick William, regent on March the 22nd and the simultaneous announcement of his abdication. The Emperor has the right to personally direct the Government of the Empire. The spirit of the times is unfavorable to despotism, and the position to govern an enlightened country like Germany by means of a military autocracy is a bold challenge that will be readily taken up. It seems impossible that the attempt can result in anything but a repetition of the events that have convulsed Russia for several years past.

The Belleville Ontario thinks the Farmers' Sons' Franchise act was the embodiment of a much needed reform, and entirely repudiates our view that it was a corrupt piece of class legislation. Class legislation is to all intents and purposes a bad law, and has always been found to draw innumerable numbers into its train, so that we have some cause for censure in this respect. Will the Ontario tell us that the young men in Belleville or in Kingston, clerks and others, who have no votes, are not just as intelligent, honest, and capable of exercising the franchises as the country cousin? It is absurd to suppose otherwise; and for what reason was an invidious legislative distinction made between them, except that the agricultural element largely preponderates in Ontario?

In making a bold bid for the Presidency of the United States Mr. Blaine not only gave the opportunity for showing up the shakiness of the American diplomacy, but he called down upon himself the ridicule of the thoughtful portion of the American press. The good faith of contracting parties to treaties is a matter of such importance that no nation can afford to commit a breach of it, even though it should fail to observe a very high standard of honour in its international dealings. The United States having committed itself to a joint protestation of the Panama Canal by a treaty signed by the Chief of Police, and vice versa, Mr. DeVita insisted in his old and trustworthy position of Chief of Fire Brigades, and the young men in Belleville had still and now, in return for all the great service rendered the city in the defense of the canal, the right to be protected in the cold of iniquity. I say therefore that the City Council, knowing Chief Horsey must legally occupy the port, must now end the cold war.
