SPORTS AND RECREATION.

Winter Races Coming on—Baseball Items—Episodes Full of Interest.

Sparting matches are to be prohibited in Montreal.

There will be horse races at Picton on Jan. 12th and 13th.

Isaac Murphy, Lucky Baldwin's jockey, is worth \$125,000.

The Toronto curlers were defeated by the Buffalos on Thursday; score 96 to 64.

The American Yacht club will extend its annual regatta to six days the coming season.

The Torontos, of the international league, are booked for exhibition games in Cincinnati on April 9th and 10th.

The Prince of Wales is president of the Grand National Hunt committee, the ruling power of British steeple-chasing.

It is probable that New York will have both Kelly, of Chicago, and Denny, of St. Louis, on his league team next season.

Thos. Stevens, the bicyclist, who left San Francisco on a bicycle tour around the world in April, 1884, arrived there yesterday from Japan.

The stockholders of the Scranton baseball club have made later offers to purchase Oswego's franchise in the international league. They have been informed that it is not for sale.

Nearly £400,000 changed hands over the recently run Melbourne cup. One bank alone had a call for close on to £100,000.

The book-makers were hit hard all during the meeting.

Manager Curry, of the Oswegos, thinks the Binghamton team will be the weakest in the league, and he fears the Rochester sluggers will not prove as formidable as many people think.

Hereafter championship and all other prize ring fights, in which professionals enter the ring to contend for, must be fought in England according to the new rules of the London prize ring.
