CAIN AND ABEL.

DR. CURTISS' NOTES ON THE SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON.

Lesson III for Sunday, Jan. 16—Lesson Text, Gen. iv, 3-16—Golden Text, iv, 9: "Am I My Brother's Keeper?"—Without God in the World.

Is Sin Hereditary?—Did Adam introduce sin into the world? Old Testament history answers yes. The disobedience of the progenitor of the race is followed by an unbroken chain of transgression.

THE LESSON.

The Offerings (vs. 3-5).—At an indefinite time after the fall we read of two sacrifices, offered by the first brothers, which they seem to have brought without divine command, of their own free will.

God saw lurking in Cain's heart envy and murder. He seems to have regarded him with something of the same abhorrence that he did Israel in the time of Isaiah (Isa. i, 15).

The Warning to Cain (vs. 6, 7).—But God is merciful to Cain in calling him to account, in reproving him and in still offering the hope of pardon and favor.

The murder (vs. 9, 10).—This view seems to be sustained by the following verses. When God puts the question, "Where is Abel thy brother?" he replies, "I know not; am I my brother's keeper?"

In almost dramatic language God is represented as asking Cain, "What hast thou done?" and as saying, as we would translate the passage, "Hark! thy brother's blood is crying unto me from the ground."

The Punishment (vs. 11, 12).—It might seem here, as in the case of Adam, that the chief punishment was inflicted by God; and that if his hand had not been laid upon Cain he would have had some comfort in life.

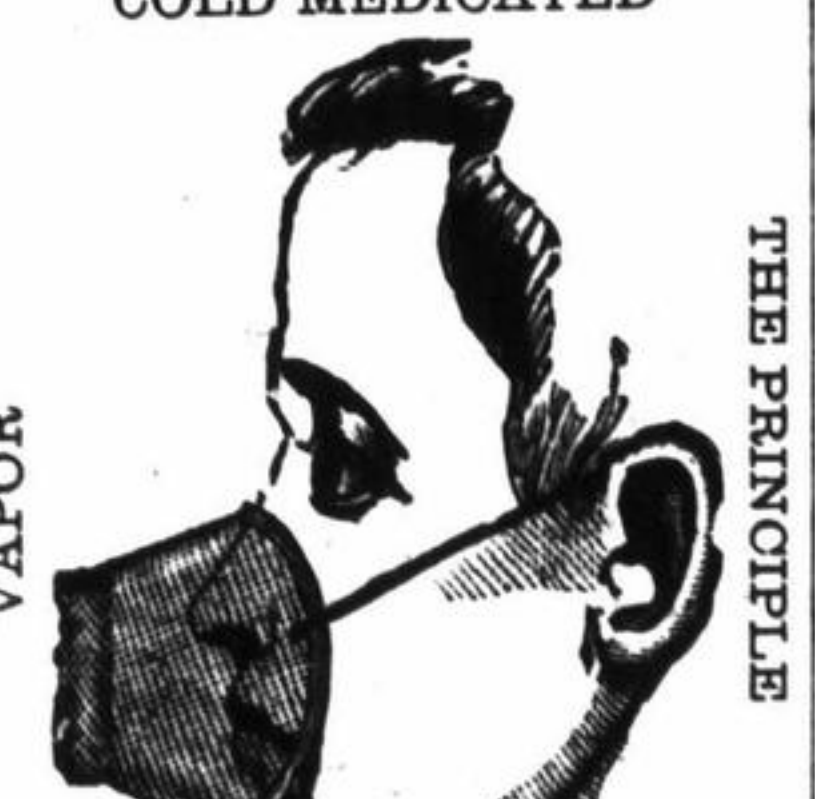
