TEMPERANCE TOUCHES.

The Sports Must Not Drink—Beecher on the Prohibition Question.

Contributed by the W.T.C.U. Attorney-General Bradford, of Kansas, says: "The saloon is fast disappearing from the state."

The novel features of two lady members acting as commissioners of education drew a curious crowd to the first meeting of the new board in New York.

"If so great is the evil of the liquor traffic in the United States that it would be necessary to vote for the abolition of all liquor, I would vote for it."

"The sentiments of my principles are my own, my vote belongs to my party" will surely never find favor with the "Woman's Christian Temperance Union"; but as the women of Canada go into public life more than they have been wont, the polluted atmosphere of politics shall be made purer by their presence.

At a meeting of the Executive committee of the Dominion Alliance, held last Saturday afternoon, the following resolution was passed: "That we regret that neither the recent utterances of Hon. Mr. Blake nor those of Hon. Mr. Foster on the question of prohibition are in harmony with the position of the Dominion Alliance, and we strongly urge upon our friends the desirability of carrying out the programme laid down by the conventions of September, 1885, and September, 1886, by supporting for parliamentary positions only such candidates as are known and avowed prohibitionists, and who will do all in their power to attain the declared objects of the Alliance, namely: (1) The immediate enactment and thorough enforcement of total prohibition; (2) the perfecting and enforcing of the Scott Act; (3) the abolition of the Dominion senate, or its reform in such a way as to bring it into harmony with the moral sentiment of the community."

THE Y.M.C.A. CONVENTION. The Organization of the Associations Plenty of Good Work Done. Delegates to the Y.M.C.A. convention arrived in the city to-day. Among them were the secretaries of various Canadian associations, and of the international committees.
