SNOWSHOE COSTUME.

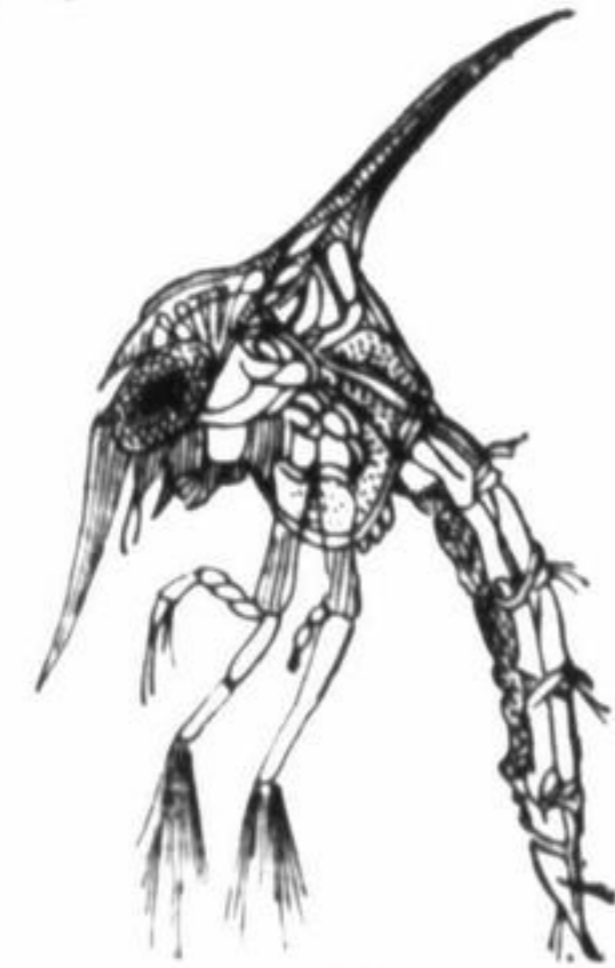
The picture represents the Canadian snowshoe costume. The great coat and knee-breeches are of heavy woolen, such as blankets are made of.

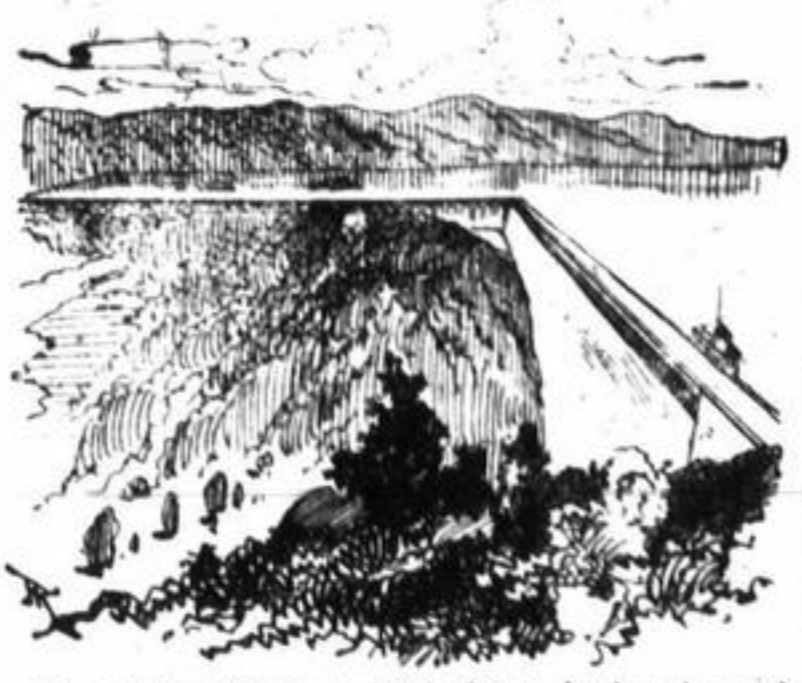

The Quaker Bridge dam that it is proposed to build for the storing of water for the needs of the city of New York will be the biggest engineering work of its kind.

The Quaker Bridge dam will receive, and it is hoped retain, the entire water supply of the Croton valley.



It will be 277 feet high from bed-rock, and 136 from the residuum of sand, etc. The storage capacity of the dam will be 32,000,000 gallons.
