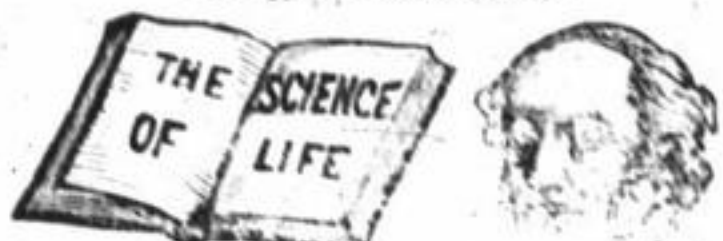

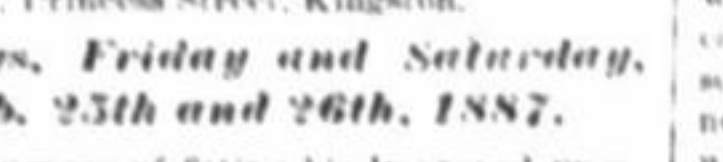

PLEADING FOR SODOM.

NOTES ON THE INTERNATIONAL SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON.

For Sunday Feb. 20--Text of Lesson Gen. xviii, 23-33--Golden Text, Heb. III, 2--Critical and Practical Notes by Samuel Ives Curtis, Ph. D., D. D., of Chicago.

Introduction.—Lot in Sodom.—We left Lot just outside of Sodom (Gen. xiii, 12). In due time he became a citizen of Sodom.

At the time of the events described in this chapter Abraham was over 90 years of age (Gen. xvii, 1). God had appeared to him again, had promised him a numerous posterity...

Abraham's Plea.—He does not ask that the wicked should be spared. He does not intimate that they have not had a sufficient opportunity for repentance.

THE LESSON. Vs. 21-25. With these verses begins a plea which is without a parallel in the entire Scriptures.

Vs. 21-25. Without a parallel in the entire Scriptures. To appreciate it we must remember the truly Oriental character of the transaction. Abraham, with all his reverence, is here shown to be a genuine child of the east in asking for more favorable terms in connection with each petition.

Vs. 27-32. Abraham becomes bold in his plea. Like an Oriental making a bargain, as we have remarked, he drops from point to point in his intorsement until he reaches ten. He is all humility. He speaks of himself as dust and ashes in God's sight.

The question may be raised, if God would have promised to save the city for the sake of five righteous persons. The sequel, however, shows that there were not even five (Gen. xix, 10).
