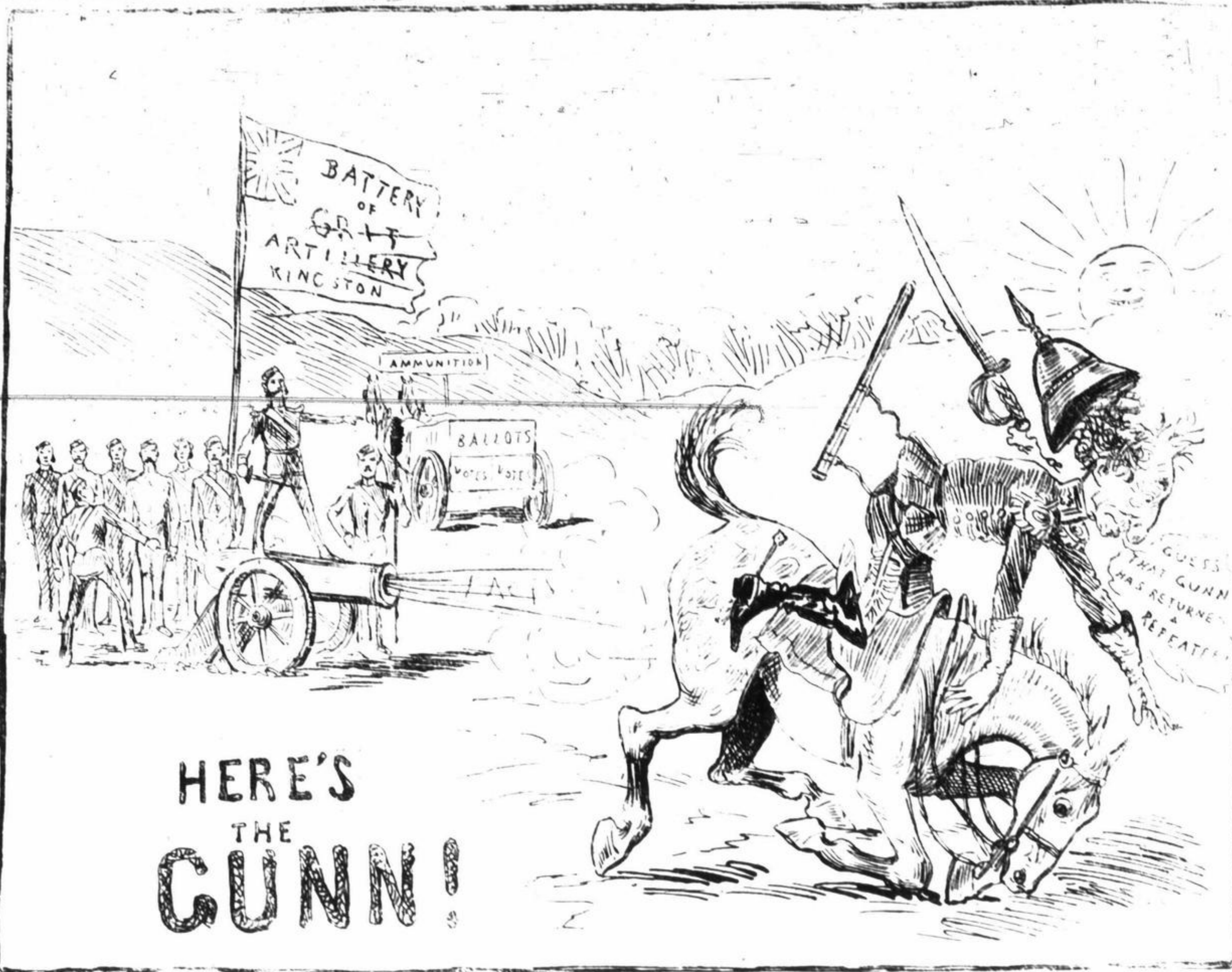

THE COUNTY CAMPAIGN.

Mr. Kirkpatrick Attacks the Policy of Reform at Cataraqui.

Although there is no direct political issue at stake in the Frontenac election, Mr. Lawden being an independent with only a partial leaning to the policy of reformers, yet Mr. Kirkpatrick's attack upon that policy deserves some attention in the interest of healthful discussion. He stated that the revenue was now fully equal to requirement. How is it that the deficits of 1885 and 1886 were each rolled into the millions? The plain inference is that the cabinet has been grossly extravagant.

He said that the north west was not mis-governed, so as to provoke rebellion. Whom are we to believe, then, Mr. Kirkpatrick, or the conservative papers and members, which have admitted gross neglect?

He said that conservative rule had made Canada happy and prosperous. How is it, then, that rebellion and secession movements alone prevail when that party is in power, as witness two nor west rebellions and the Nova Scotia repeal movement? How is it, if such prosperity prevails, that there is more land mortgaged in the midland district than ever before; more people selling out each spring and fall, as the auctioneers will attest; that this fall and winter these same auctioneers had the greatest difficulty in making sales of farm stock and implements successful at even present low prices, selling only a small proportion of offerings in many cases; that more Frontenac farmers have moved to the Western States in the past five years than ever before; that much destitution and absence of work prevails in the city, with more failures in January than has long been known before within the same month? Are these the usual signs of prosperity? We have it from the hundreds of farmers who visit us at this season that times were never harder or money scarcer with them than now.

He spoke of Toronto's remarkable growth of \$30,000,000 in assessment in five years, and ascribed it to the N.P. Is it not rather a tribute to the prosperity of the seat of Reform government for fourteen years?

He declined to discuss the reign of lawlessness at Ottawa, and ascribed it to the false cry of "corruption" rampant for twenty years. This was what Sir John and his party all said before convicted of the Pacific scandal, what Mr. Rykert said before exposed the other day in Lincoln, what the boy Beatty is saying in Toronto, what John White says in Hastings, what other members proven corrupt are saying. But who believes them?

Mr. Kirkpatrick said Reformers claimed that the government should be run for the same figure as at the confederation period. When and where have they done so? Surely when there were a dozen live issues he did not discuss he need not have created one. This is what Reformers show:

Mr. Kirkpatrick pictured very highly the greatly enlarged Kingston markets and the high prices the citizens were complaining of. We leave it to the farmers who find it hard sometimes to sell a full load to judge whether they are growing wealthy from market sales, and as the prices the market tolls bring are, when taken for a long period of years, the best indication of the size of the markets we append the official record. They do not encourage Mr. Kirkpatrick's roseate picture, for the markets brought more during the Mackenzie regime at Ottawa:
