

POLITICAL AGREEMENT.

IT GUARDS AGAINST THE EXPENDITURE OF BOODLE.

How the Thing Came About—Both Parties Profess a Desire for a Pure Issue—Who Pledge Themselves to Stand by the Arrangement.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS—THAT whereas it is the desire of both political parties in the city of Kingston to prevent, at the pending election for the house of commons of Canada, in the said city, any violation of the provisions of the election act respecting corrupt practices at dominion elections, and to see that the provisions of the said act, to wit 37 Victoria, chapter 9, are faithfully carried out, and that there is no breach, especially of section 92 respecting bribery, of section 94 respecting treating, of section 95 respecting intimidation, and of section 96 respecting the hiring of vehicles and carrying of votes to the poll;
