GREAT FLOOD IN DAKOTA.

A Very Large Tract of the Countries Lying Under Water--Great Damage.

BISMARCK, March 21.--The gorge at Sibley Island is still intact, despite the use of dynamite. The scene here is desolate and dreary. The river is still over six miles in width, the gorge at Sibley Island holding water to the highest mark that it reached yesterday.

The worst is coming. The great rise at Fort Buford is now half way here, and will reach this point some time to-night. This will make the highest water ever known in these parts, and unless the gorge breaks at Sibley Island the city of Mandan will be in danger of annihilation.

The high trestle of the Northern Pacific railroad is wrecked. Bismarck is the terminus of the Northern Pacific. Yesterday's passenger train, with its load of people, bound for the Pacific Coast and intermediate points, lay on the side track here all night, and will not be able to leave for several days.
