

ALL AROUND THE HOUSE.

Up Stairs, Down Stairs, in Kitchen and

in the Lady's Parlor. There is a very delightful way by which you may tell the hour of day by means of flowers, asserts Frederick G. Mather. There are twenty-four varieties of plants whose blossoms open successfully at the different hours of the day and night. The African marigold opens at 7 in the evening and closes at 4 in the morning, but if it does not open the next day will be rainy. Most varieties of the water lily close and sink into the water at sundown to arise and bloom at sunrise. The day lily opens at 5 o'clock in the morning, and the morning glory a little later. The night blooming c reus opens only at night and closes before the dawn.

Lemon Cream Biscuits.

Cream biscuits with lemon are very delicious, and M. Felix Delies gives the following receipe for making them: Put into a basin and work well with a wooden spoon the volks of six eggs, six ounces of sugar and the rind of one lemon chopped fine; beat the six whites to a froth and mix with the yolks; add four ounces sifted flour and about one pint of well whipped cream; mix the whole carefully. Pour this preparation into eight or more oblong white paper cases, besprinkle with sugar, put on a baking sheet and bake in a brisk oven nearly ten minutes; dish upon a napkin and serve hot.

Shad as Epicures Like It.

Shad is undoubtedly most delightful when broiled, and this is the easiest way to cook it. Rub the double broiler with butter or beef suet to prevent sticking. The fish should be split down the back. Expose the inside to the fire first. Turn frequently, taking great care that the skin side does not burn. A medium sized fish will cook in from ten to fifteen minutes. When the bone parts readily from the flesh it is done. Carefully remove to a hot platter. Sprinkle with pepper and salt, then a few drops of lemon juice, some parsley chopped fine and melted butter over all. Put in the oven to soak for a minute or

Ink Stains on Mahogany or Cherry.

The following often acts satisfactorily in removing old ink stains from polished mahogany and cherry: Add a very few drops of nitre to a teaspoonful of water, dip a feather into this mixture and touch the ink spot with it. When the stain disappears rub the spot at once with a rag wet with clear water, then dry and polish. This is to prevent a white mark coming in place of the stain.

A Pretty Wash Stand Splasher.

A pretty wash stand splasher may be worked with etching silk on coarse white linen. The design should be traced off on white tissue paper and the paper tacked to the linen. The design is then worked through the paper, which is afterward torn off. Finish the splasher by hemming it around, edge with lace and tack a ribbon bow in each

A Burlap Screen.


A very satisfactory screen is made by covering a frame with ordinary burlap. If it is desired to decorate this, a good way is to use figures cut out of cretonne. Very large Japanese and Chinese designs with figures, temples, trees and birds are best adapted for the purposes. Paste them on and buttonhole the edges loosely with crewel.

Old Fashioned Apple Sauce.

Old fashioned apple sauce of deep red brown color is very appetizing. Fill a deep pudding dish with chopped apple, put in two cups of sugar and one cup of water; use orange or lemon peel for flavoring, and bake slowly two or three hours.

Draperies for Doors and Windows. A favorite method of decorative display

nowadays consists in the artistic draping of doors and windows. These draperies do much toward furnishing a room and may be costly or inexpensive, according to the means of the furnisher.



SUGGESTION FOR DOOR DRAPING. The accompanying cut from The Decorator and Furnisher presents a very pleasing model that may be copied in either rich, heavy stuffs or light, inexpensive material. It also affords a pleasing change from the usual mode of looping curtains and portieres alike on both sides.

Household Hints.

A little petroleum added to the water with which waxed or polished floors are washed improves their appearance.

A fruitful cause of erruptions of the skin is the use of poor soaps. For toilet purposes only the best and purest of soaps ought to be

Two cups of brown sugar, half a cup of molasses, one and one half cups of water, butter the size of an egg, and two cups of peanut meats, furnish the ingredients for peanut candy. Boil until thick.

In hanging out skirts to dry always pin them between two lines and they will take up less space and dry much sooner than when hung double.

Put heavy wrapping paper under new oil-cloth, so it will not stick to the carpet and leave paint on it.

To remove mildew, soak in buttermilk and spread on the grass in the sun. Hand painted china holds its own well, although conservative people prefer the plain

white ware. Rubber rings such as are used on fruit cans become hard and brittle. They can be restored by letting them lie in water in which you have put a little ammonia. Mix in this proportion: One part ammonia and two parts water. Sometimes they do not need to lie in this more than five minutes, but fre-

quently a half hour is needed to restore their elasticity. A few drops of ammonia in alchobol furnishes an admirable mixture for cleaning blnek elothes


