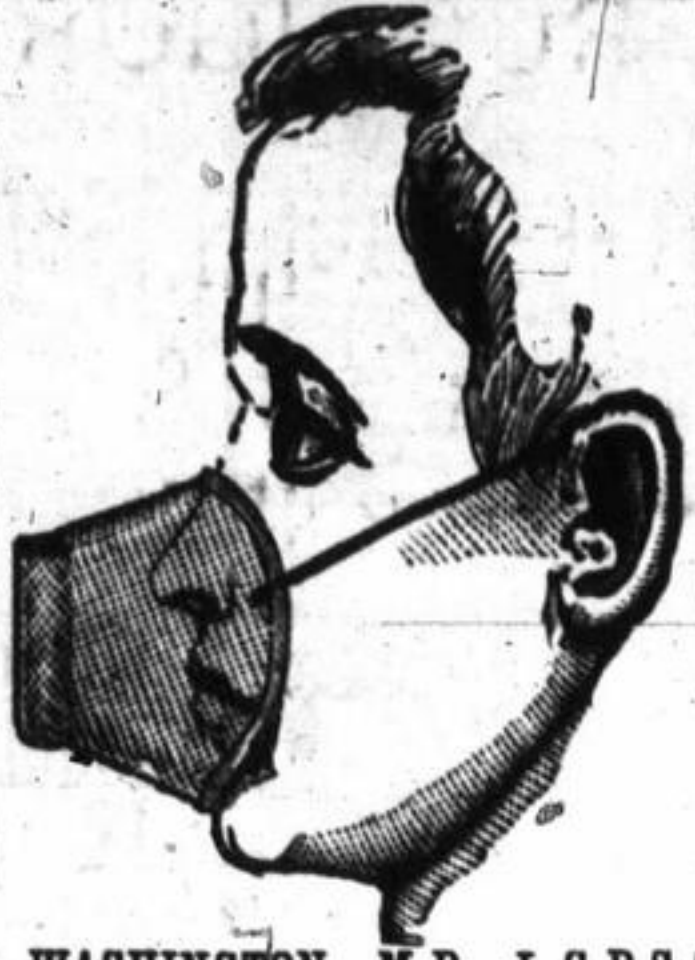

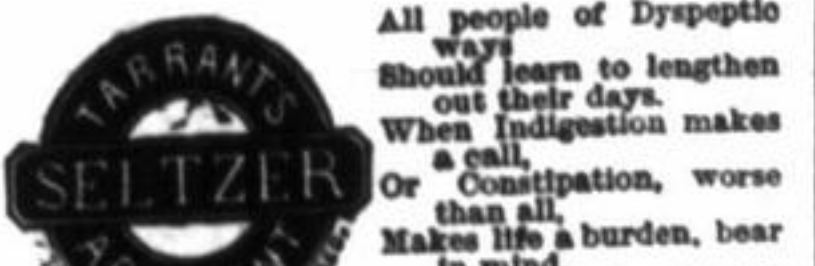

MARKET TOLLS.

SEALED AND SEPARATE TENDERS will be received at City Clerk's office, City Hall, until THURSDAY, JULY 28th INST.,

At 12 o'clock noon, from persons willing to lease the Market Fees and Weighing Charges of MARKET NOS. 1 AND 2,

Collectable under and subject to the provisions of the City By-laws now in force in this behalf for the term of one year, from the first Monday in August next to the first Monday in August, 1888.

The Tenders to express, in words at length, the sum of money to be given for the lease of each Market, and to be endorsed 'Tender for Market Fees, Nos. 1 and 2, as the case may be.

No petition will be entertained by the Council for any reduction whatever of amounts stated in Accepted Tenders.

The Lease shall be subject to any by-law which the City Council may pass, altering the present regulations respecting the sale of fresh fish, and also to the Act of Ontario, Chap. 17, 46 Vic., Sec. 1.

No attention of Tenderers is particularly drawn to the fact that the weighing of fresh meat in the City Scales from and after the First Monday in August, 1887, is to be optional with the buyer.
