

TOWNSHIP OF PITTSBURG.

MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL.

December 15.—The Council met at nine o'clock, a.m. All the members present.

The following accounts were passed: J. Scott, \$2, for cedar for culverts; Wm. Spence, \$2, for stone; D. McKee, \$2, for stone; J. Scott, \$2, for work on 7th road; J. B. Black, \$1.50, for broken stones; F. C. Brash, \$1.50, for work on 4th road; Mrs. Todd, \$2.29, for stone furnished for road; C. H. J. J. J., \$22, for stone and ditching road; J. J. J., \$1.20, for repairing culverts; J. J. J., \$4.92, for stone; Wm. McRae, \$10.13, for lumber; and W. Woods for repairs on road.

The Reeve reported that he had been served by the Sheriff with two writs in the case of Weaver vs. the Corporation of Pittsburg, and that he had employed Mr. Agnew to defend the same. The Council approved of his action.

On the bill from the House of Industry it was resolved that \$20 be granted for the maintenance of papers from this municipality.

The report of the Committee appointed to investigate the claims made by Mr. Todd was read, recommending that no compensation be paid. Moved by Mr. Graves, seconded by Mr. Bell, that the report be adopted.

Moved by Mr. Bell, seconded by Mr. Martin, that Mr. Graves procure six tons of stone for the front road, near Ruid's quarry.—Carried.

Moved by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Graves, that Wm. Irwin and Michael Keys be paid for stone broken by them when the same is measured by the Road Engineer.—Carried.

The Council adjourned sine die.
