RUSSIA'S TRIRD DIVISION.

RUMORED ABOLITION OF CLAR NICHOLAS' PAMOUS IMPRICUTION.

(From the New York Herald.) The Moscow Guzette asserts that Count

Schouvaloff is likely to be appointed Min-ister of the Interior, with a department of political police in his ministry, in lieu-of the third division of the Imperial Chancollerie, which will be abolished. Under the harmless designation of the 'third division' of the Supreme Court of Justice belonging to his Imperial Majesty, there has long existed, over and above the Ministers of the secret police, a creation of the Emperor Nicholas, designed to bring into a more regular system the secret control hitherto more freely occupied over all suspicious inhabitants of the sacred Empire. In every Russian town of any note there appears a colonel or captain of the gendarms corps in a light blue uniform, whose official sphere is nowhere legally sircumscribed and limited, but of whom every one knows the fact that he is the overseer of the Governor, and of all the chief officers and magistrates of the Province, and that he has the rich to interfere in every important agair, and to demand information respecting it. The officer is generally an agreeable man, with polished manners, and everywhere an honorary member of all societies and associations. At the same time he is the head of a class of peo ple whose visits he receives after sunsol. and who transact business with him about which no honest man cares to trouble himself. Everything which excites attention or deserves attention is communicated by this 'blue officer,' who is the most dreaded man in the town, and who has no respect for persons, to his superior, the chief of the 'third division,' and loy is carried on directly by the 'third division.'
