THE FISHERY COMMISSION .- Whether Canada will get anything, and, if any-thing, very much, from the Fiseries Commission, as compensation for throwing open her fisheries to the United States, remains to be seen. The amount which the Government organ at Ottawa thinks would be fair is something between two and three millions. The amount which some other newspapers deem reasonable is ten millious, or at the rate of half a million a year. The claim put in on behalf of Canada by Great Britain is twenty millions. Yesterday the Mail got the figures up to sixty millions. As the Commission is to sit for six months the probabilities are that, if the figures continue to mount up at the rate they have been doing, it would bankrupt our neighbors to pay the com-pensation demanded. It would be a sad state of affairs, however, if Canada should get nothing .- Telegram.
