How The Clause Reads.

For the benefit of "Citizen," clause e'even of the by-law relating to the running of freight cars over the street railway line, reads thus:

"That freight cars shall be hauled along and over the company's railway so as not to hinder, delay or in any way interiere with the running of passenger cars thereon, pursuant existing agreements between the corporation and the company; and the corporation shall have the right make such rules and regulations, orders and by-laws as in the opinion of the corporation's city engineer are necessary to prevent the hauling of freight cars over said railway, his dering or delaying, or in any way interfering with the running of passen ger cars as aforesaid."
