NO PUBLIC SMOKING.

When the Germans Were Not Allowed to Smoke on the Streets.

There are many old time Germans who remember how strictly the law against public smoking used to be enforced. That the law is dead is one of the fruits of the revolution of 1848.

The citizens stuck to their pipes and cigars during the following months, and the police and military dared not interfere with them on trifling provocation.

Before the revolution disobedience to the anti-smoking law was punishable by a fine of 1 thaler. If a German passed a snuff box or a royal pipe in his mouth, he was fined 5 thalers.

Where "liberty to smoke" is not yet universal, in Germany or elsewhere. In Berlin, Munich and other capitals, including Vienna, army officers and soldiers are forbidden to smoke in the principal streets through which members of the royal family are liable to drive.

Early Impressions. Memory plays queer antics at times. As our ideas of things develop and make progress the recollection of our early impressions is a somewhat strange phenomenon.

At least 53 centuries B. C. the Babylonians used a sexagesimal system of notation, consisting of six and ten, of which we have vestiges when we reckon in minutes to the hour and in seconds to the minute, or 3,600 seconds that is, a score of six to the hour. That we count 10 inches to the foot, 24 hours to the day, 300 degrees of longitude around the equator, 60 degrees of latitude from the equator to the poles and 90 miles to a degree may also be traced to the same old Babylonian system of numeration, which originally reckoned 60 shekels to the mina and 60 minas to the talent.
