OUR OTTAWA LETTER.

ABSDUR CHARGES IN REGARD TO THE GALICIAN. What Are the Facts?—The Last Official Report—Proportion of Galicians is Not Large—Sir Wilfrid and the Spaniards—Going to the Dogs—A General Election Scare—Notes.

Ottawa, July 25.—With a persistency worthy of a better cause, a section of the Conservative press is pounding away at the Department of the Interior on account of the number of Galicians who are coming into the country.

Carefully collated and placed consecutively in cold type, this string of charges and prophecies looks so absurd and preposterous that many will doubt if the half of them were ever uttered before.

From the last official report the following facts are quoted in the Mail and Empire: At Ganor, twenty miles from Winnipeg, there are 32 families who had purchased for cash farms averaging eighty acres per family.

Such then is the report of the Inspector, as published in the Conservative organ. It is now in order for the tractate of these people to show that those now arriving are in any way worse than the first arrivals, who are doing so well.

Another misconception that is likely to arise from the persistence with which the Galicians have been singled out for reproach is that none but the Galicians have been coming in this season.
