ANTI-ANARCHIST PROPOSALS.

MADE AT THE RECENT CONVENTION. Many Nations Would Not Agree to the Proposal, Among Them Great Britain and France—The Items as Suggested by the Conference. NEW YORK, Dec. 29.—A cable to the world from Rome gives the substance of proposals alleged to have been made at the recent anti-anarchist conference there. The proposals were accepted by the delegates from Germany, Austria, Russia, Italy, Turkey, Spain, Portugal, Sweden, Denmark, Montenegro, Serbia and Roumania; but Britain, France, Switzerland, Belgium, Holland, Luxembourg and Greece rejected them.

A person convicted of an anarchistic crime to be punished according to law of the country where the crime was committed; anarchistic journals to be placed under a ban, their circulation interdicted, and the editors, printers and distributors proceeded against as anarchists; all proceedings against anarchists to be conducted in secret.
