THE PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE.

HE TOUCHED ON VARIOUS GOVERNMENTAL MATTERS.

To Put the Finances of the Country on a Sound Basis—Arbitration and Reciprocity Considered—Spain Should Have a Chance to Show What She Can Do.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 7.—Among other things president McKinley touched on in his address to congress were these:

The currency question was dealt with in considerable length. After reviewing the financial operations of the government since 1860, he made recommendation with the object of putting the finances on a sound basis.

He says: "If no further legislation is had and the policy of selling bonds is to be continued, then congress should give the secretary of the treasury authority to sell bonds at long or short periods, bearing a less rate of interest than is now authorized by law."

He also recommended as soon as the receipts of the government are quite sufficient to pay all the expenses of the government, that when any of the United States notes are presented for redemption in gold and are redeemed in gold, such notes shall be kept and set apart and only paid out in exchange for gold. If we are to have any era of prosperity in the country, with sufficient receipts for the expenses of the government, we may feel no immediate embarrassment from our arrears without wanting to the danger still exists and will be ever present, menacing us so long as the existing system continues.

"I recommend that the issue of the national bank notes be restricted to the denomination of ten dollars and upwards. If this suggestion I have herein made shall have the approval of congress, then I would recommend that national banks be required to redeem their notes in gold."

"The best sentiment of the civilized world," he adds, "is moving toward the settlement of differences between nations without resorting to the horrors of war. Treaties embodying these humane principles on broad lines without in any way impeding our interests or our honor, shall have my constant encouragement."

With reference to Alaska, the president says the conditions now existing there demand material changes in the laws relating to the territory. The great influx of population during the past summer and fall, and the prospect of a still larger immigration in the spring, will not permit the longer neglect of the territory or postpone the establishment of a more thorough government. He adds that the startling, though possibly exaggerated, reports from the Yukon river country of the probable shortage of food for the large number of people who are wintering there, without means of leaving the country, are confirmed in such measure as to justify bringing the matter to the attention of congress.

As to Cuba the president declares that it is honestly due to Spain and to the United States, friendly relations with Spain that she should receive a reasonable chance to realize her expectations and to prove the asserted efficacy of the new order of things to which she stands irrevocably committed.

On the question of reciprocity president McKinley says: "In order to execute an early as possible the provisions of third and fourth sections of revenue act approved July 24th, 1897, I appointed the Hon. John A. Kasson, of Iowa, as special commissioner and authorized him to undertake the requisite negotiations with foreign countries desiring to avail themselves of these provisions. The negotiations are now proceeding with several governments, both European and American. It is believed that by a careful exercise of the powers conferred by that act some grievances of our own and of other countries in our mutual trade relations may be either removed or largely alleviated, and that the volume of our commercial exchanges may be enlarged, with advantage to both contracting parties."
